Climate change is already impacting human health. Changes in weather and climate patterns can put lives at risk in many ways. Firstly, heat is one of the most deadly weather phenomena. As ocean temperatures rise, hurricanes are getting stronger and wetter, which can cause direct and indirect deaths. Secondly, dry conditions lead to more wildfires, which bring many health risks. Finally, higher incidences of flooding can lead to the spread of waterborne diseases, injuries, and chemical hazards. It might be harder for some groups of people including children, the elderly, people with weak health conditions, outdoor workers, and people with low income. Therefore, public health groups can work with local communities to help people understand and help find solutions for the climate change impacts.
