
| Intensifier | Sample Sentence  |
|-------------|--|
| not at all  | - My tea is <u>not at all</u> warm. It's cold now.               |
| a bit       | - The weather is <u>a bit</u> warm. You can take off your coat.  |
| not very    | - Today is <b>not very</b> cold. You should not wear a coat.     |
| quite       | - It's <u>quite</u> hot. Can I open the window?                  |
| very        | - That sweater looks <u>very</u> good on you. I like it.         |
| really      | - It's a <u>really</u> expensive beanie. I can't buy it.         |
| completely  | - This concert is <b>completely</b> free. You don't have to pay. |


