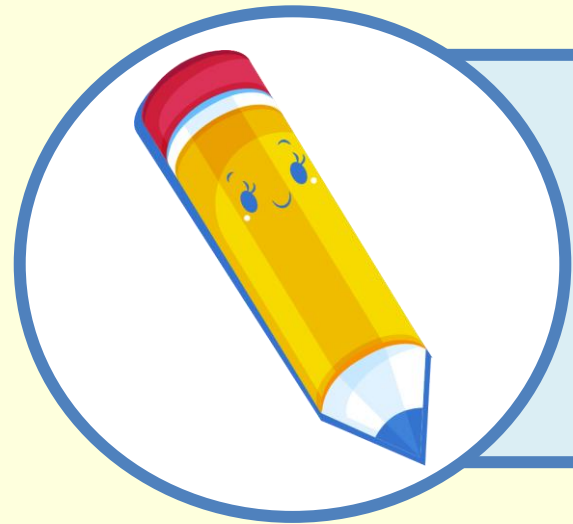

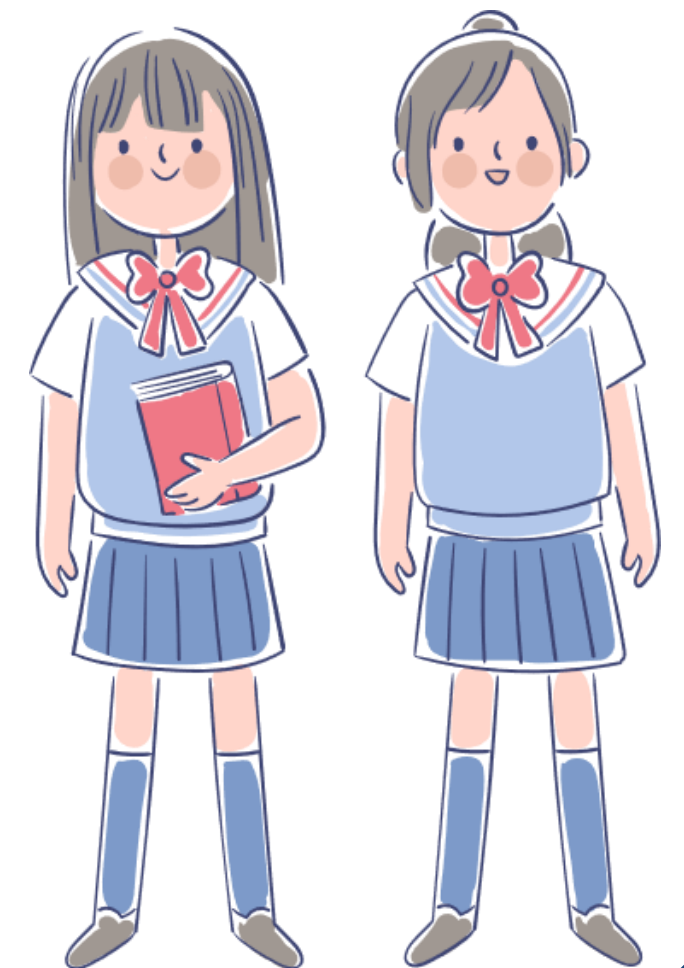
Asking about school uniforms

School uniforms around the world are both similar and different in color and style. Some schools state that students must wear suits while others require the students to wear the national costume. Let's see what students in these countries wear when they go to school.

In Thailand, wearing a school uniform is compulsory. Generally, students wear white shirts with black or khaki shorts for boys and navy-blue skirts for girls. On the other hand, Russian boys wear a suit and tie. Girls, meanwhile, are expected to wear a black dress with a white apron and stockings. Although uniforms are compulsory in Australia, each school is allowed to decide on their own style. In England, students have gender-neutral uniforms, allowing girls to choose between trousers or skirts.

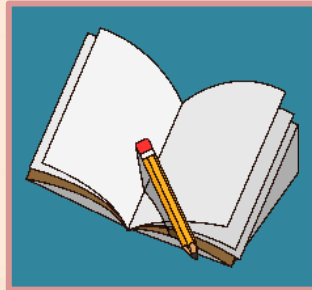
