

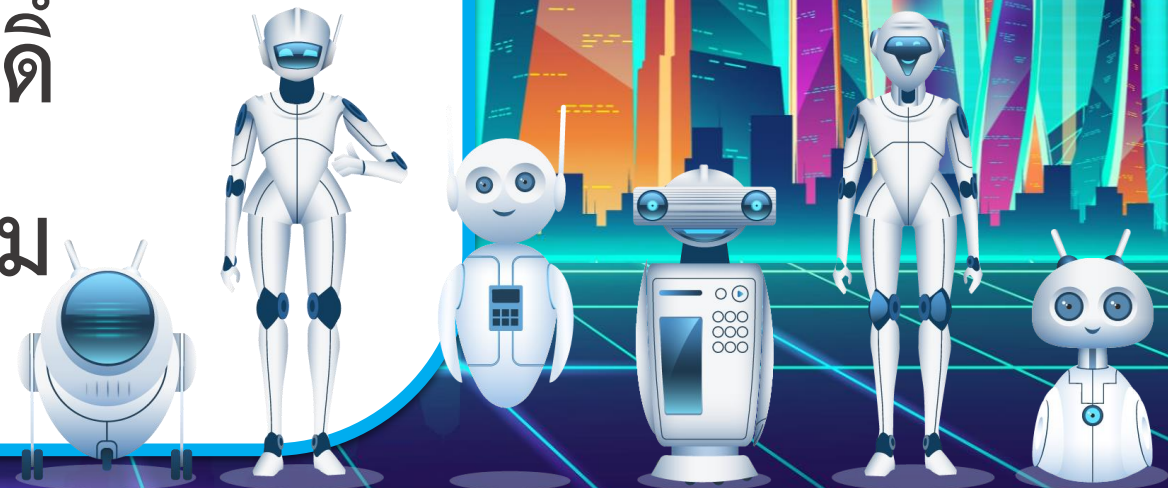

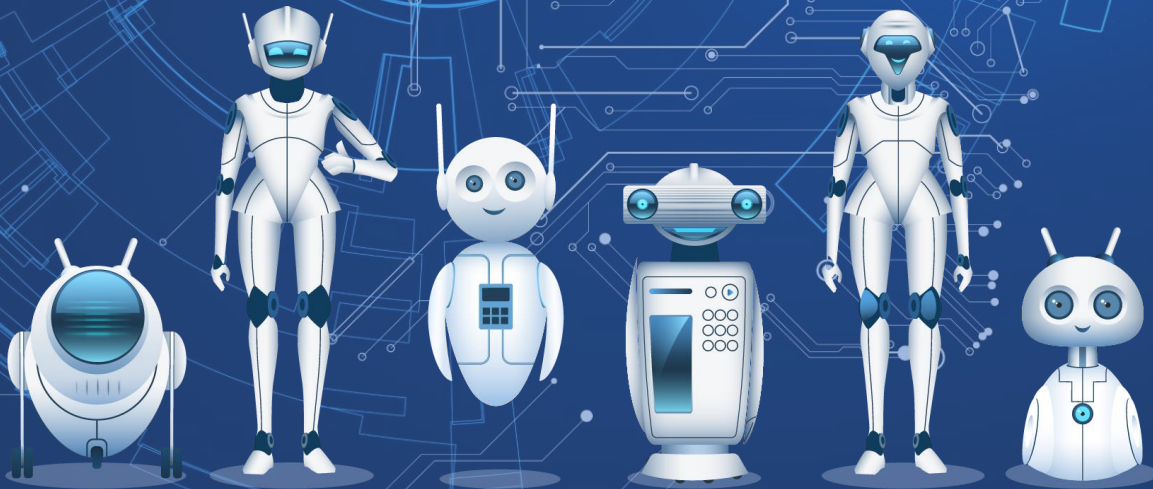

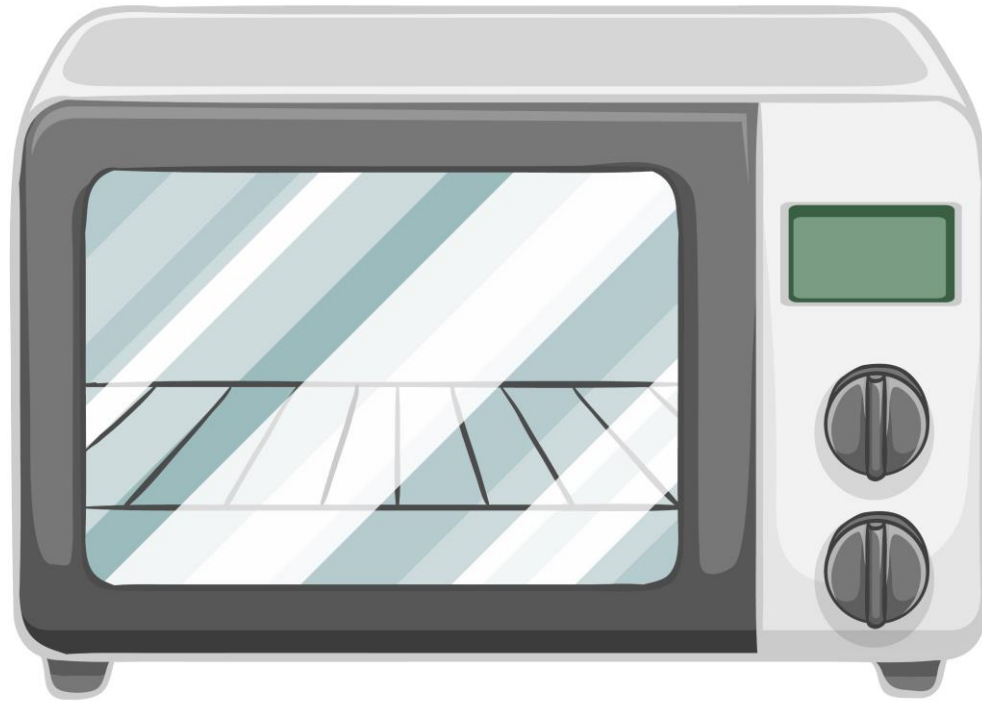

She needs a hair dryer.

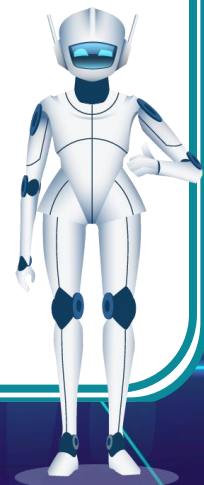
4. Why can Mike help Jane today?
