Present Continuous (Future Arrangements)

is often used to talk about future, especially about future plans when we have decided a time and a place with other people.

Brian: What are you doing tonight?

Amy: I'm staying home. (arrangements)

What are you doing tonight?

Future Time Expressions

tomorrow

next week

this weekend

in a month

Present Continuous (Future Arrangements)

We prefer using present continuous when we have made arrangements. *(a place and a time)*

We use be going to, we put the emphasis on our intention to do something.

(arrangements)

Brian: What are you doing tonight?

Amy: I'm staying home. *(arrangements)*

Brian: You're going to stay home on a Saturday night? *(intentions)*

Present Continuous (Future Arrangements)

Present Continuous

(arrangements)

Q: What are you doing tonight?

(be verb + subject + v.ing)

A: I'm staying home.

(subject + be verb + v.ing)

be going to (intentions)

Brian: You're going to stay home
on a Saturday night?

(subject + be verb + going + to + infinitive verb)

(essentially the base form of a verb with the word "to" in front of it)

Present Continuous **VS** Be Going to

1. I **am studying** Japanese at the university next year. (study)
(arrangements)

Present Continuous VS Be Going to

2. That man is very angry with the waiter. He is going to leave without paying. (leave)
(intention)

Present Continuous VS Be Going to

3. John and Mary are going to have
dinner in an expensive restaurant
this evening. (have) (intention)

Present Continuous VS Be Going to

4. What are you doing for your holidays this summer? (you do)
(arrangements)

Present Continuous VS Be Going to

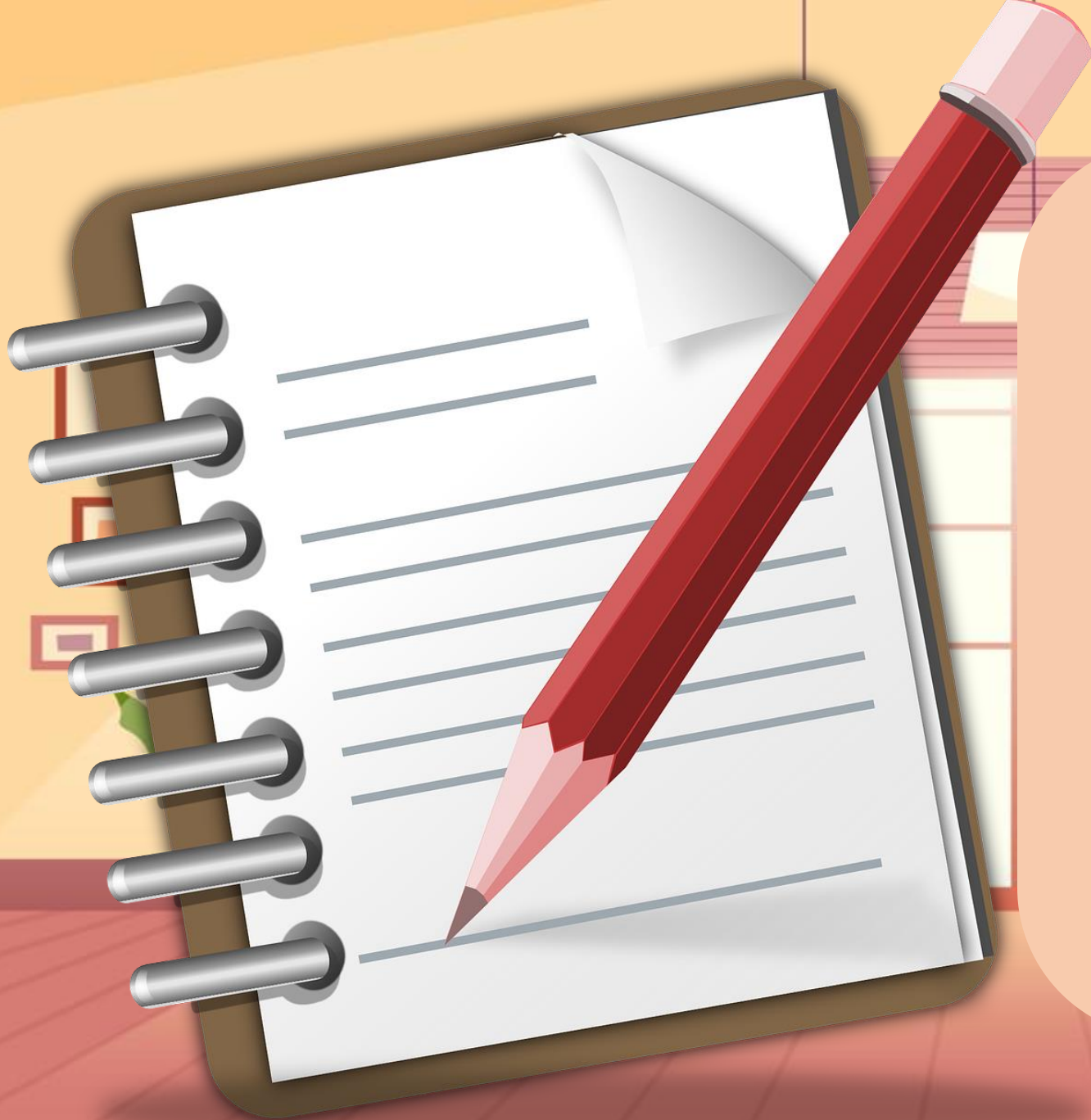
5. I am getting that job today!
(arrangements)
I don't want to be unemployed
any longer! (get)

Present Continuous **VS** Be Going to

6. If you are rude to everybody,
nobody is going to like you.
(like) (intention)

Present Continuous VS Be Going to

7. Aunt Mary is coming to see us next week. I'm looking forward to it. (come) (arrangements)
