

Participles used as adjectives

Present Participle (-ing)

It is used to describe <u>something</u>, <u>someone or</u> <u>a situation</u>.

Ex. Q: How was that film?

A: It was <u>amusing</u>.

Ex. Pattaya is a really **exciting** place. I can't wait to be there.

Participles used as adjectives

Past Participle (-ed)

- It is used to <u>describe how people feel</u> about something or someone.
- **Ex.** I was <u>surprised</u> that my mother asked me about traveling plans.
- Ex. Q: How was your class?
 - **A:** I am **bored** with a difficult subject. I always did it poorly.




