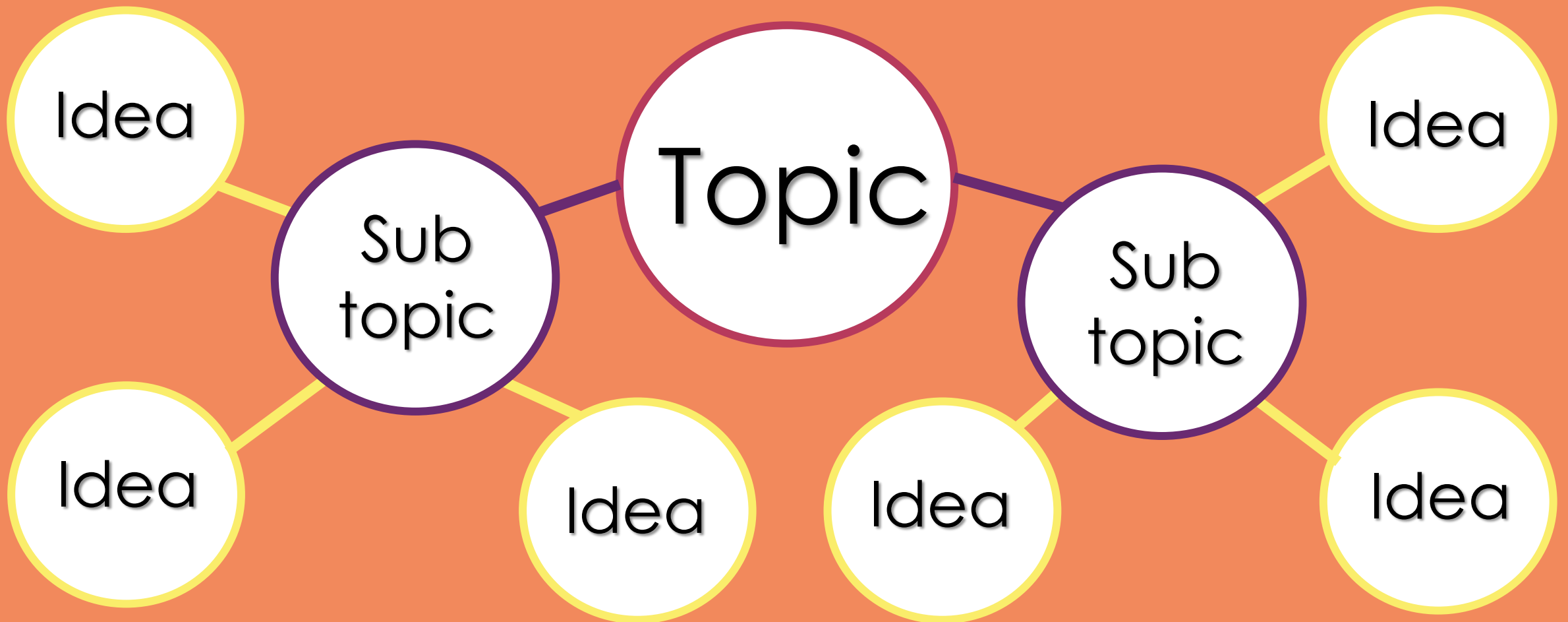
Graphic Organizer Cluster Diagram

more detail on that topic.

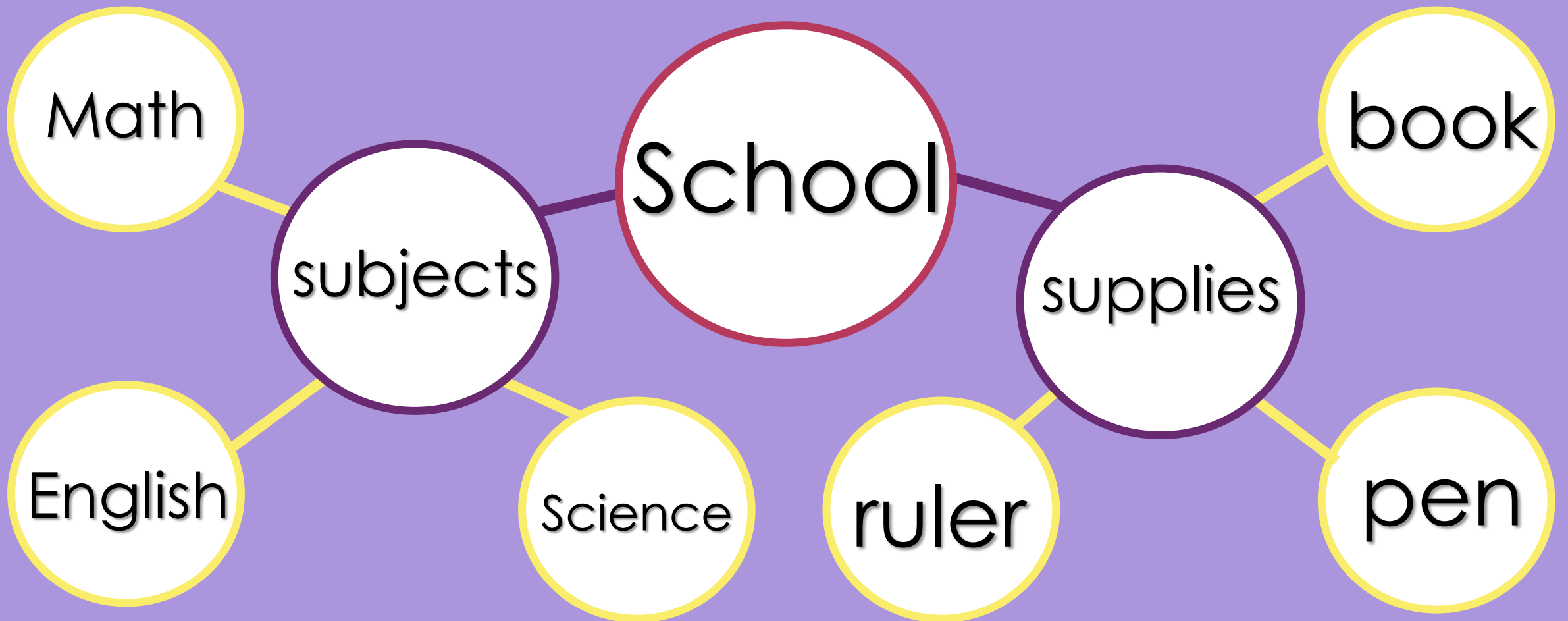

Cluster Diagram



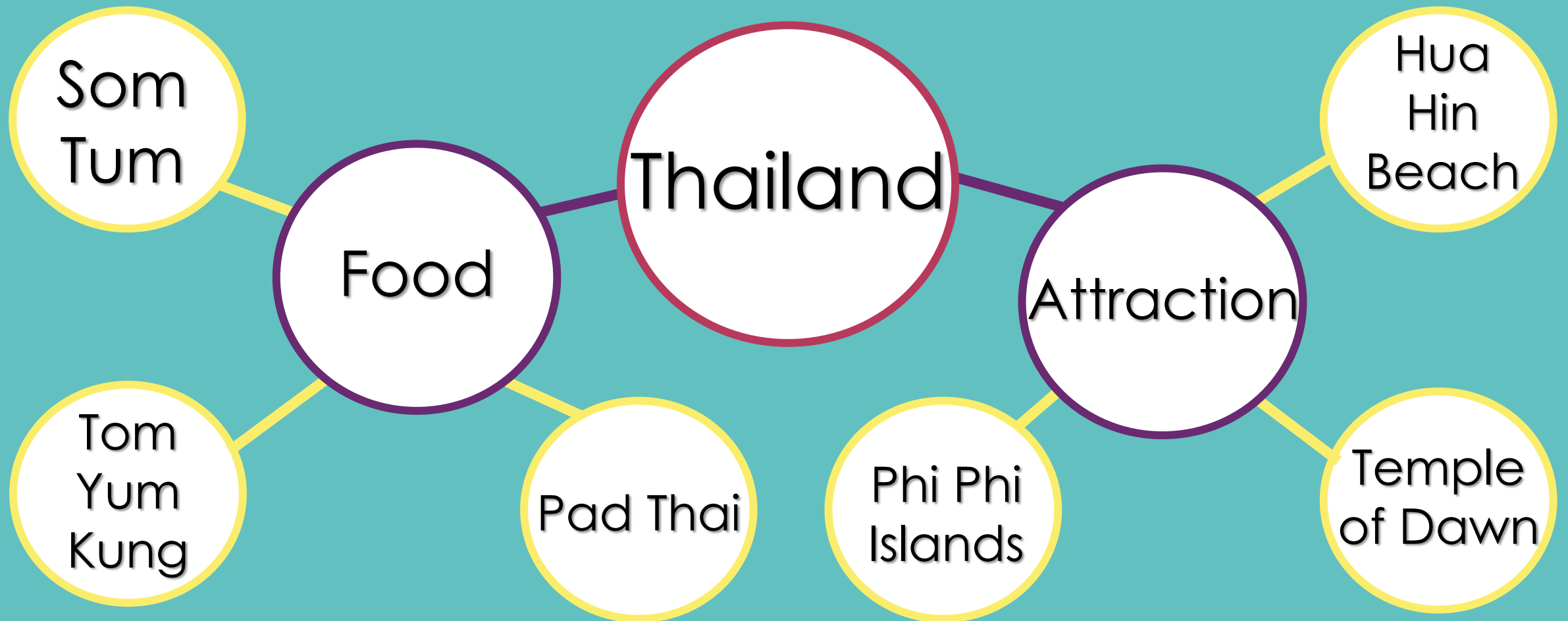
