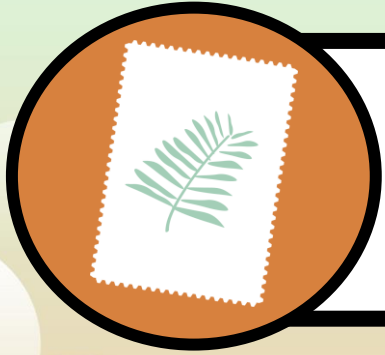

A place where people on holiday put up their tents

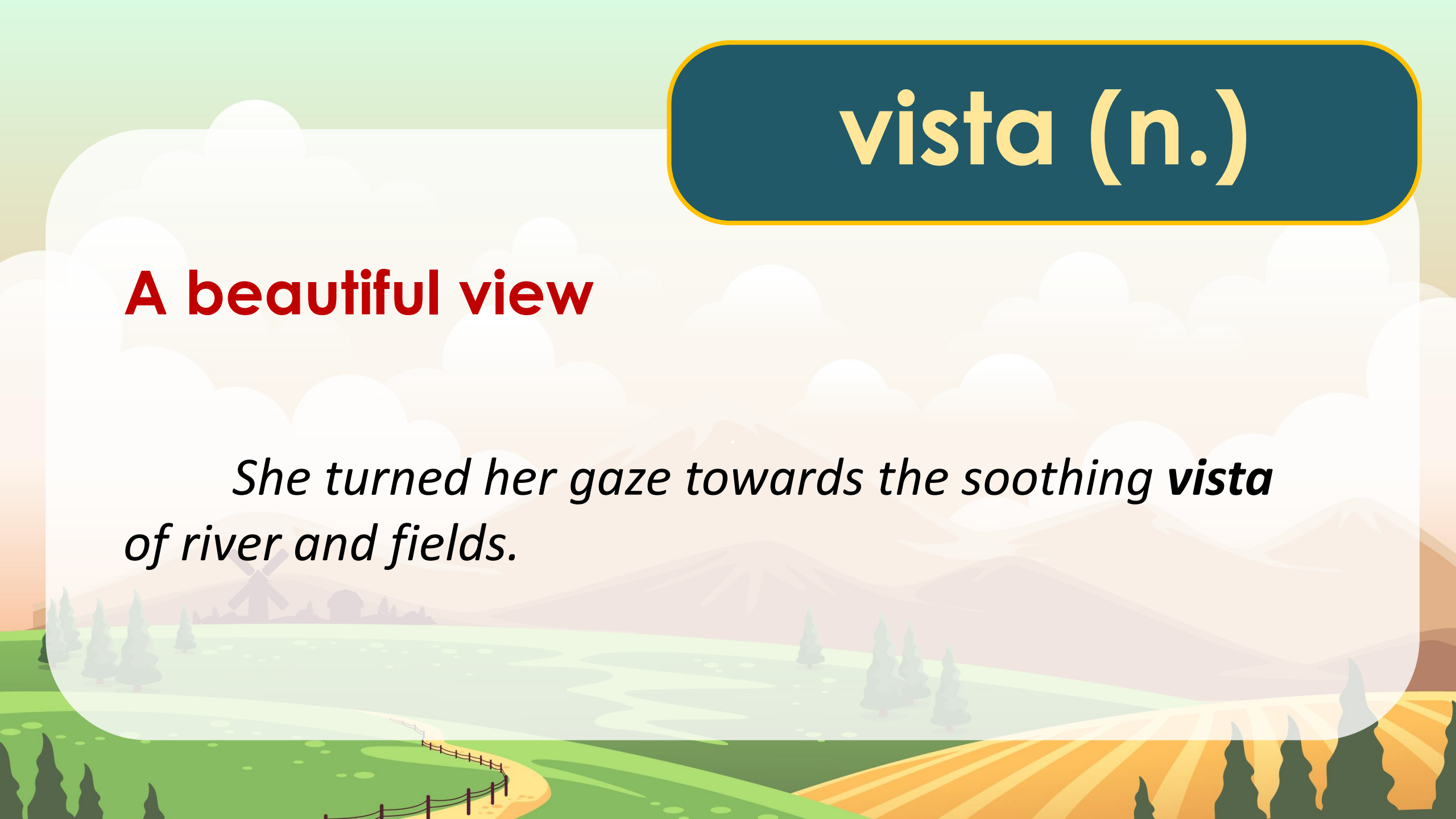
*There are many facilities at the **campsite** here.*

*Bangkok is a popular tourist **destination** in Thailand.*

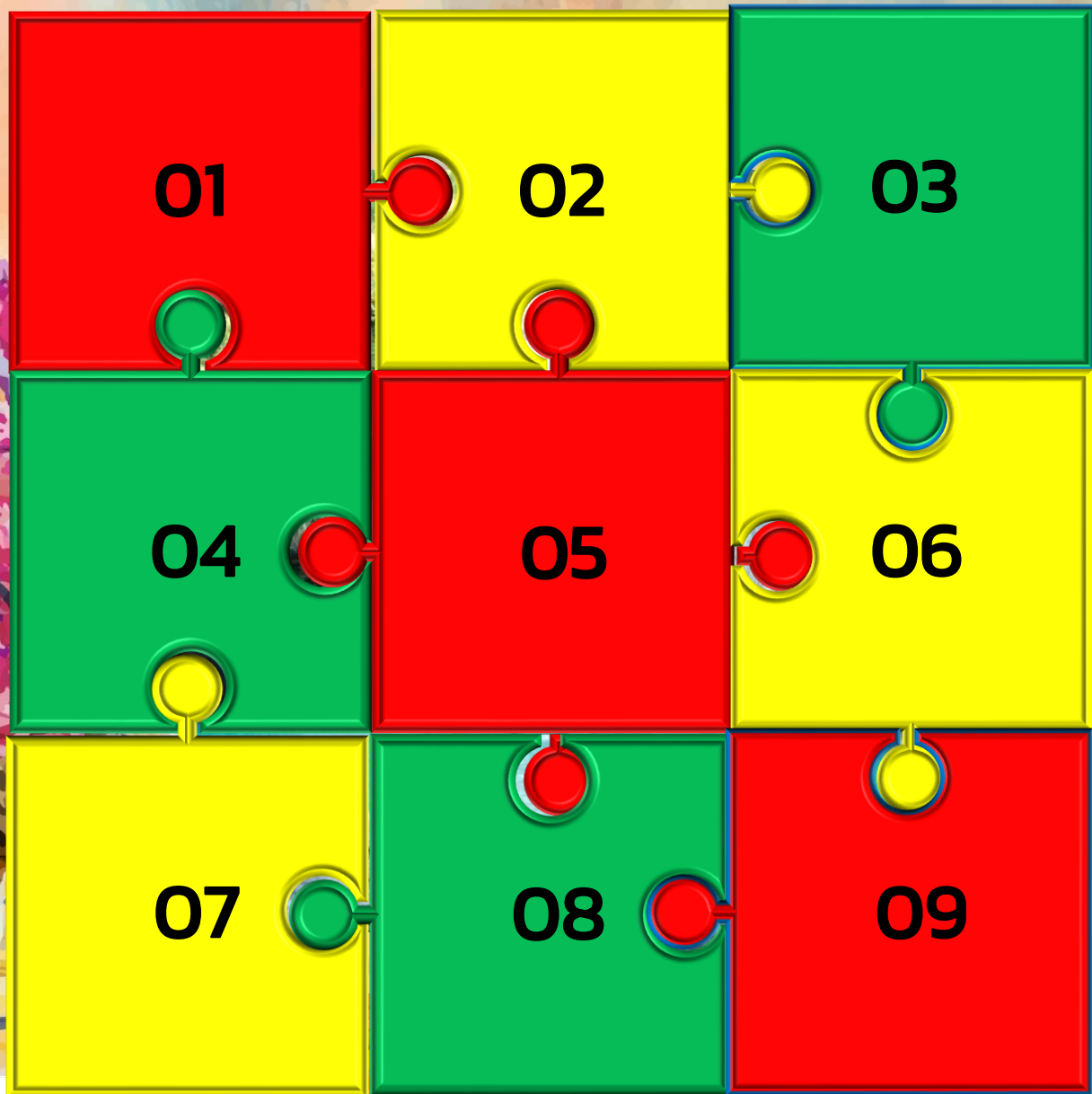


attraction (n.)

Ko Luang Waterfall

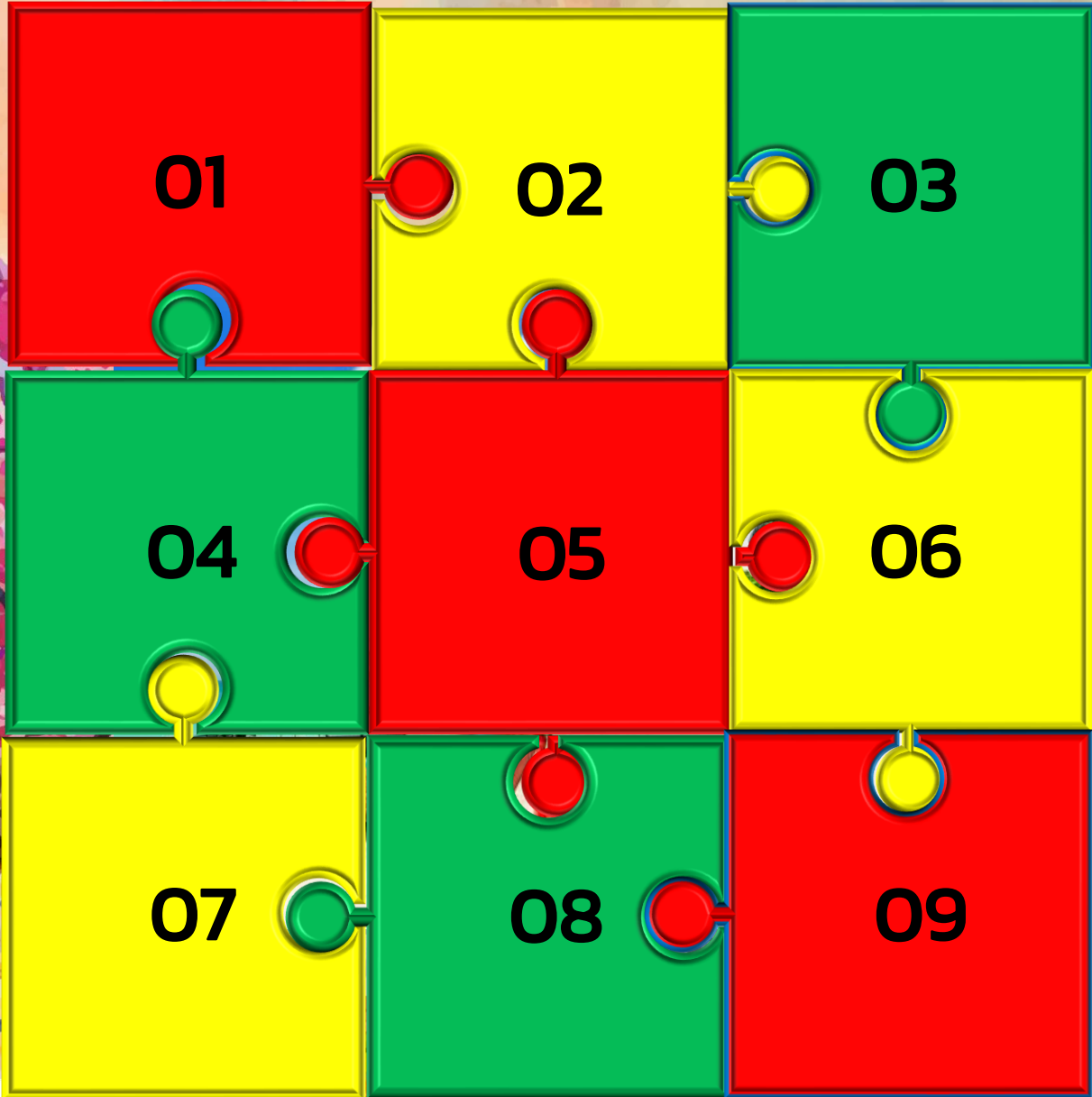

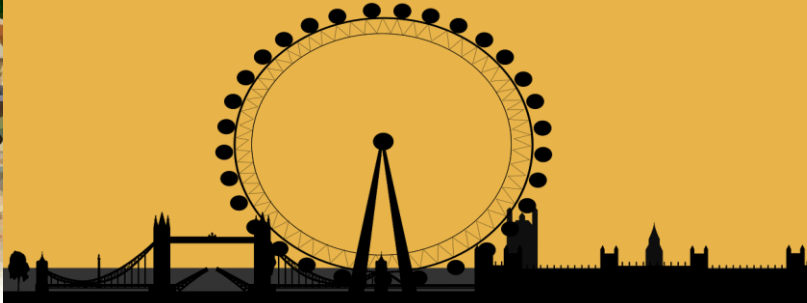
It may take some time to reach Lamphun's Li district, **but** those who make the effort will be rewarded with Thailand's most breathtaking vista.

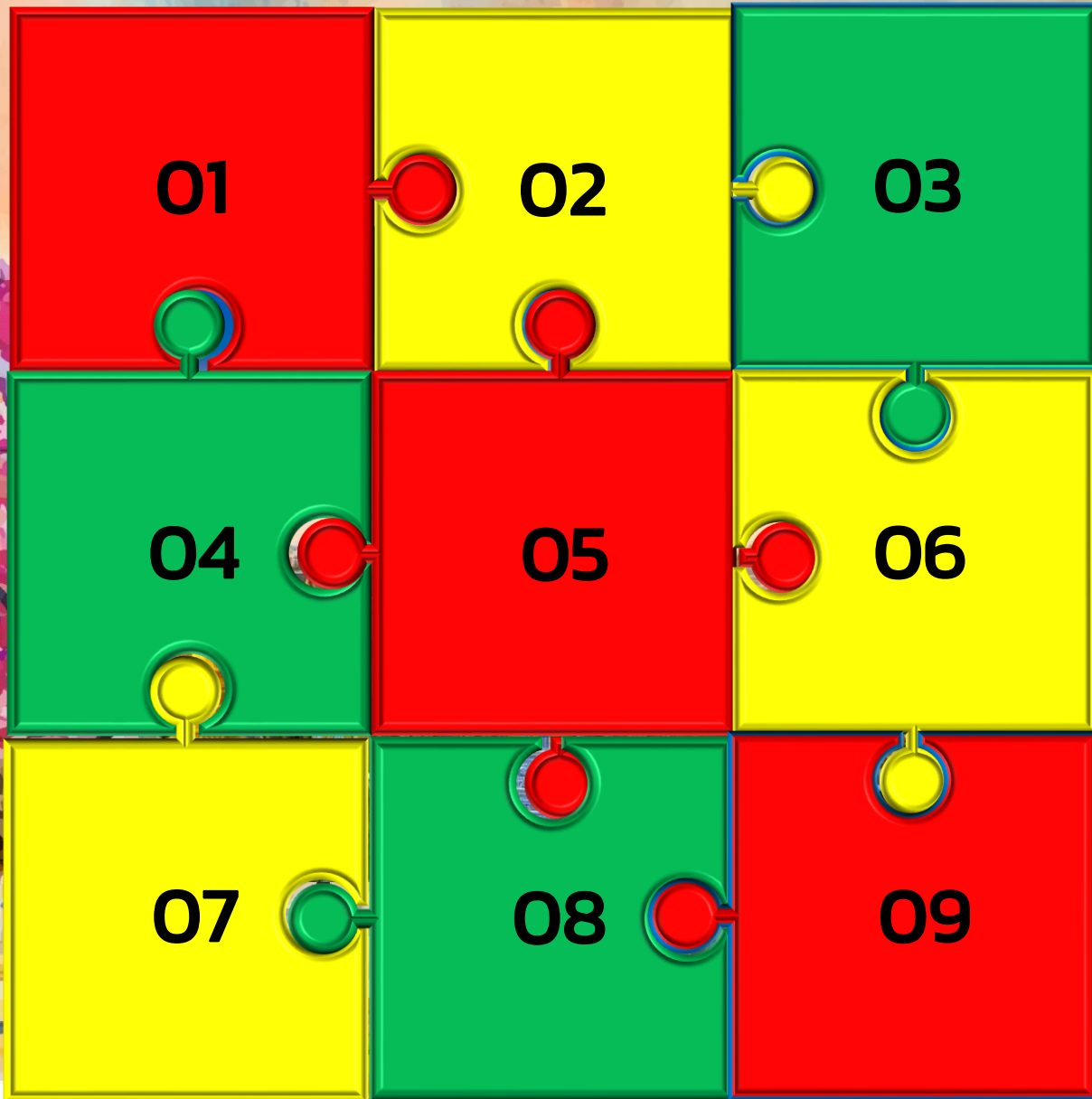


Railay

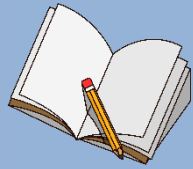

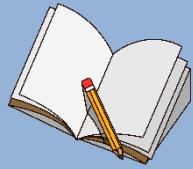

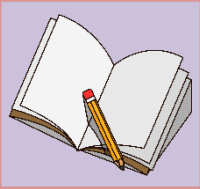
