Sugars that can be harmful to the teeth.

asthma (n.)



Bronchial asthma (or asthma) is a lung disease

Air pollution may cause many diseases such as cancer and asthma.

poisonous (adj.)



full of or containing poison

Factories release poisonous chemicals, and other wastes into water.

garbage (n.)



wasted or spoiled food and other refuse, as from a kitchen or household

Garbage is unpleasant to look at.
