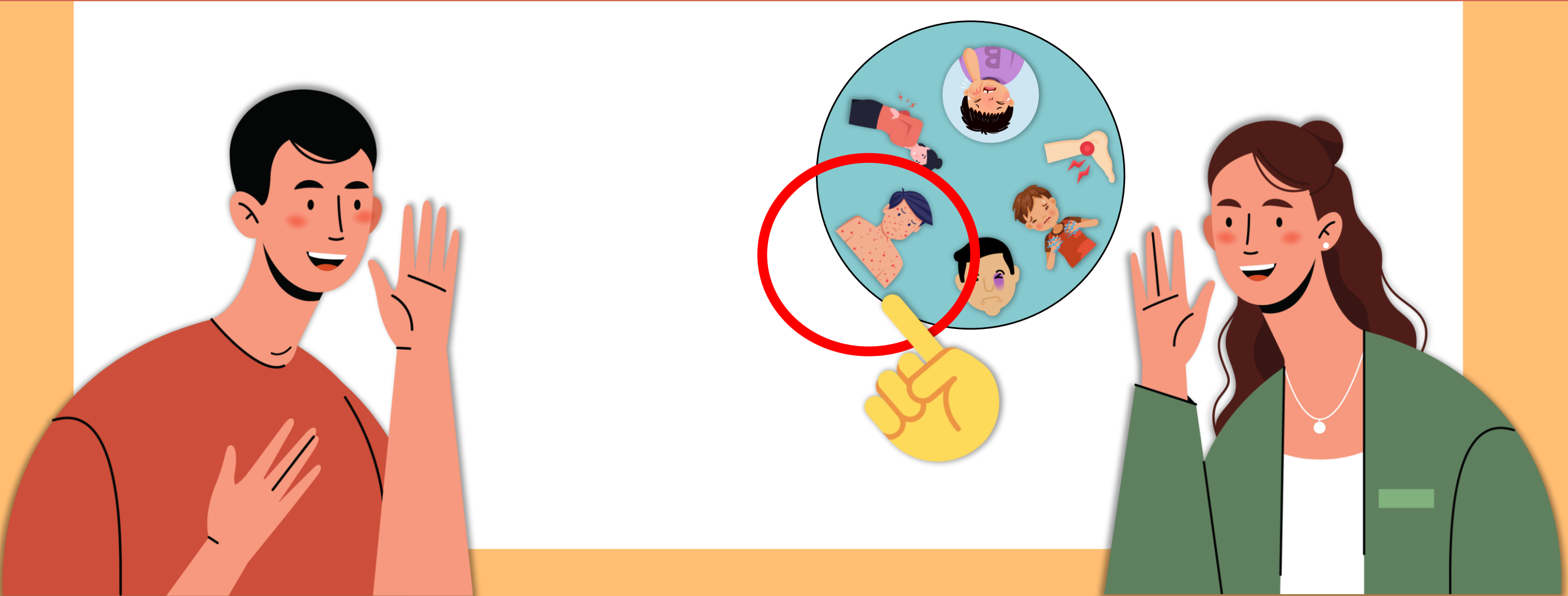
3. Flip up the card

by bad digestion.



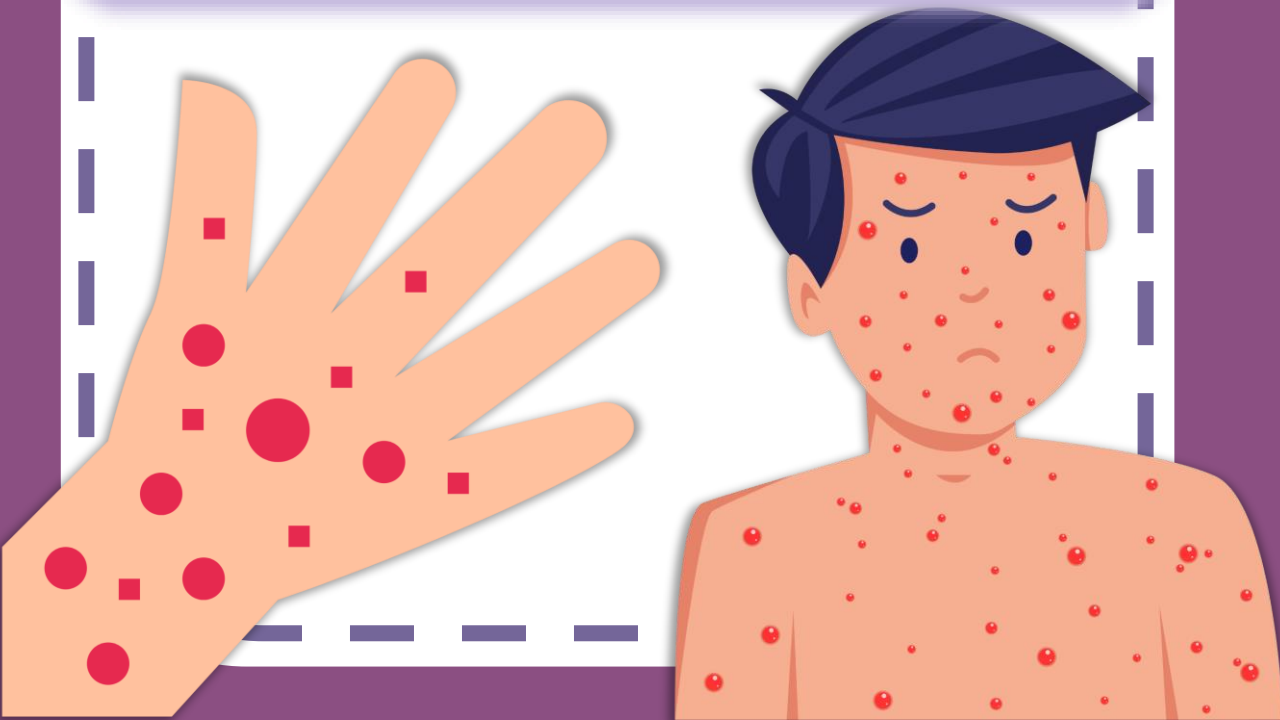
rash (n.)

got an ankle **sprain**.



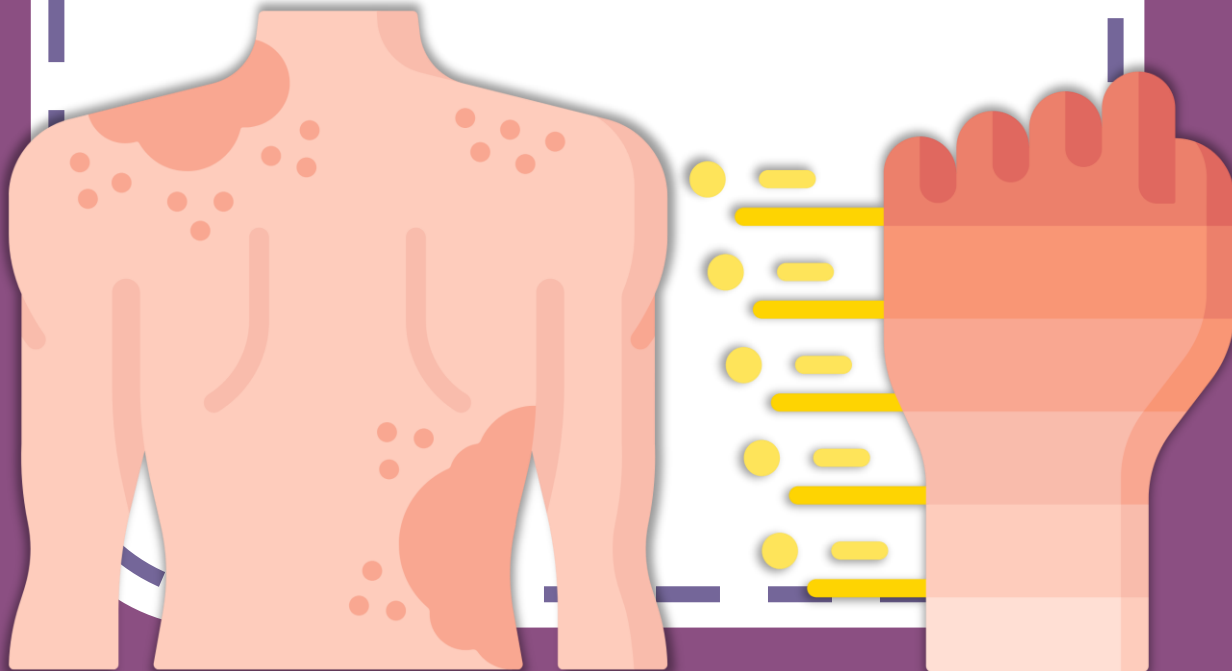
sunburn (n.)

corner of his mouth.

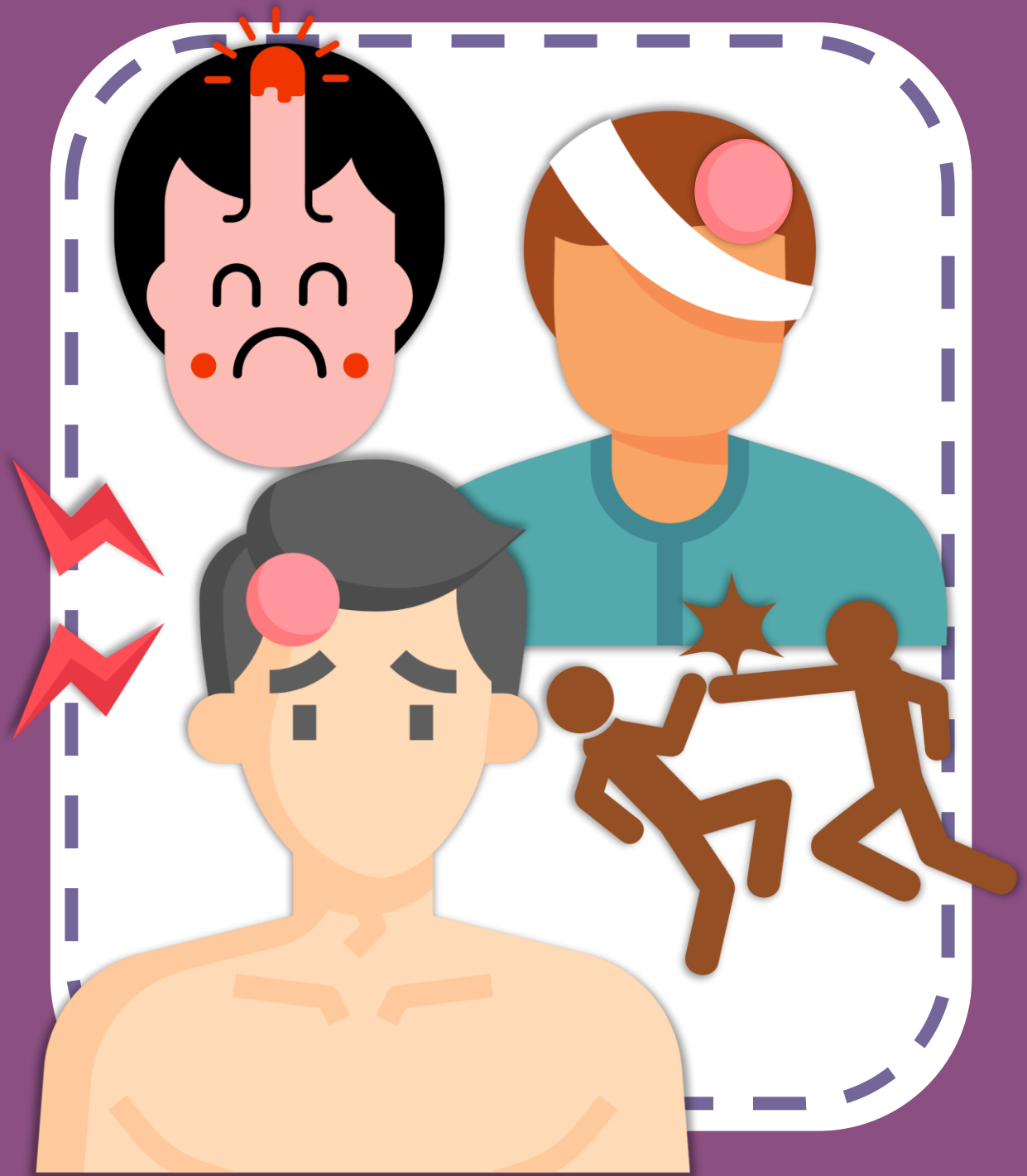


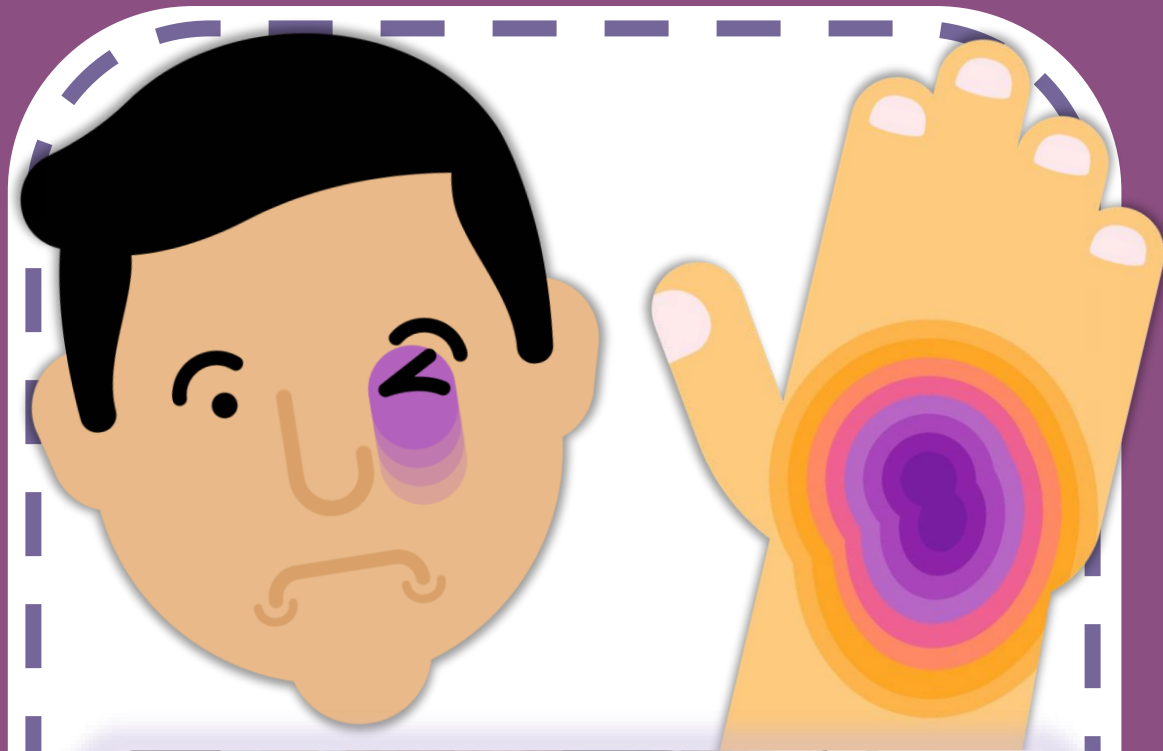
