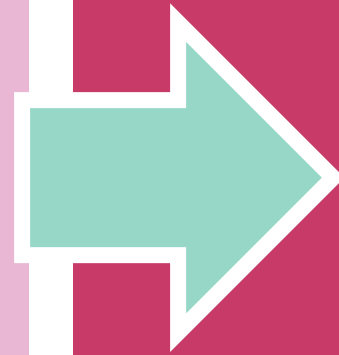
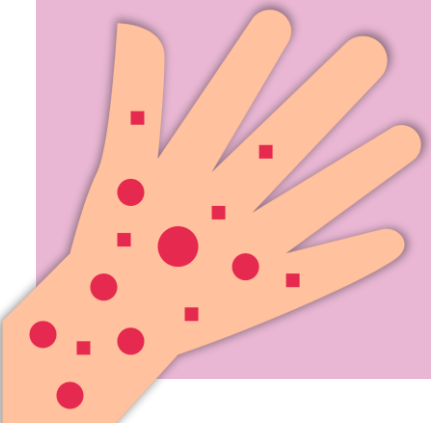




# Conditional Sentence

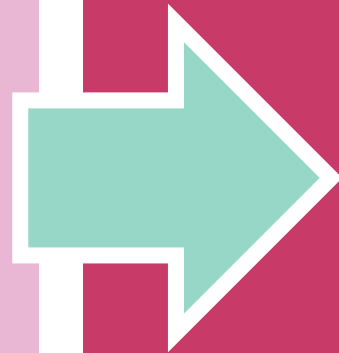
## Type 1

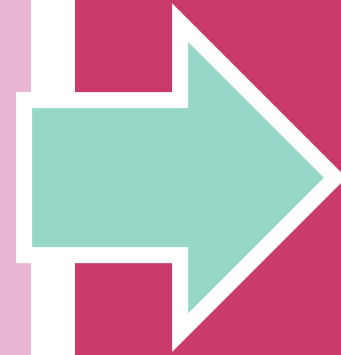

and the situation is **real**.

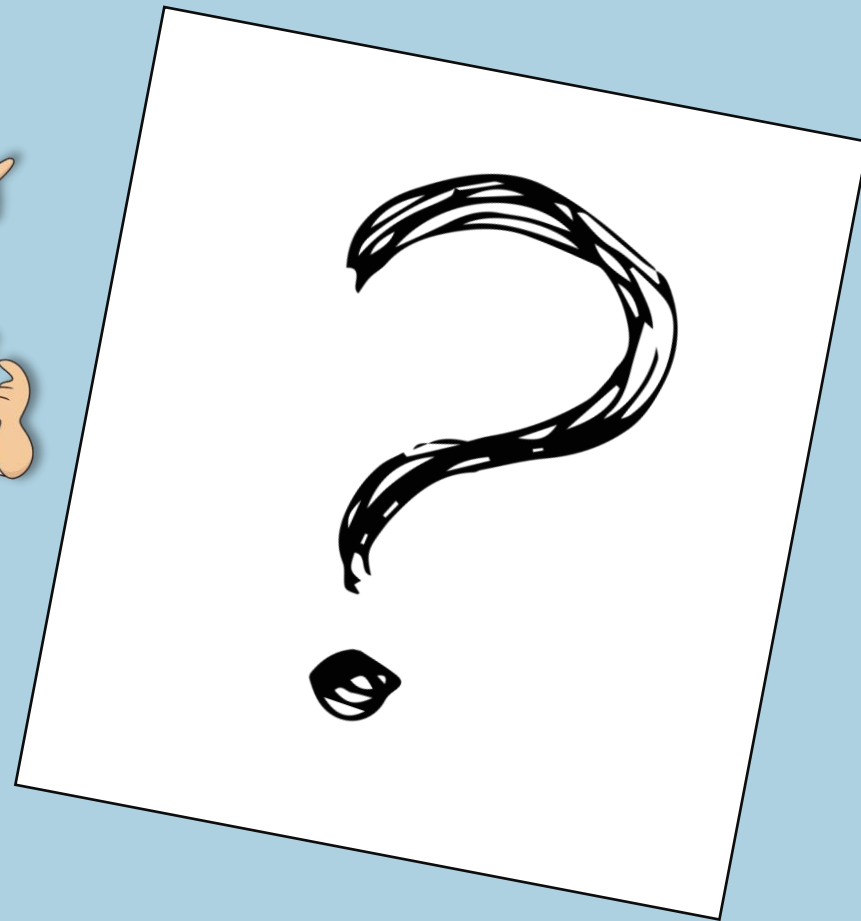
