Henry Ford

Henry Ford was an American industrialist and business magnate. He was the founder of Ford Motor Company. Ford created the first automobile that middle-class Americans could afford, and his conversion of the automobile from an expensive luxury into an accessible conveyance profoundly impacted the landscape of the 20th century.

Steve Jobs

Steve Jobs was a charismatic pioneer of the personal computer era. With Steve Wozniak, Jobs founded Apple Inc. He and Wozniak co-founded Apple in 1976 to sell Wozniak's Apple I personal computer.

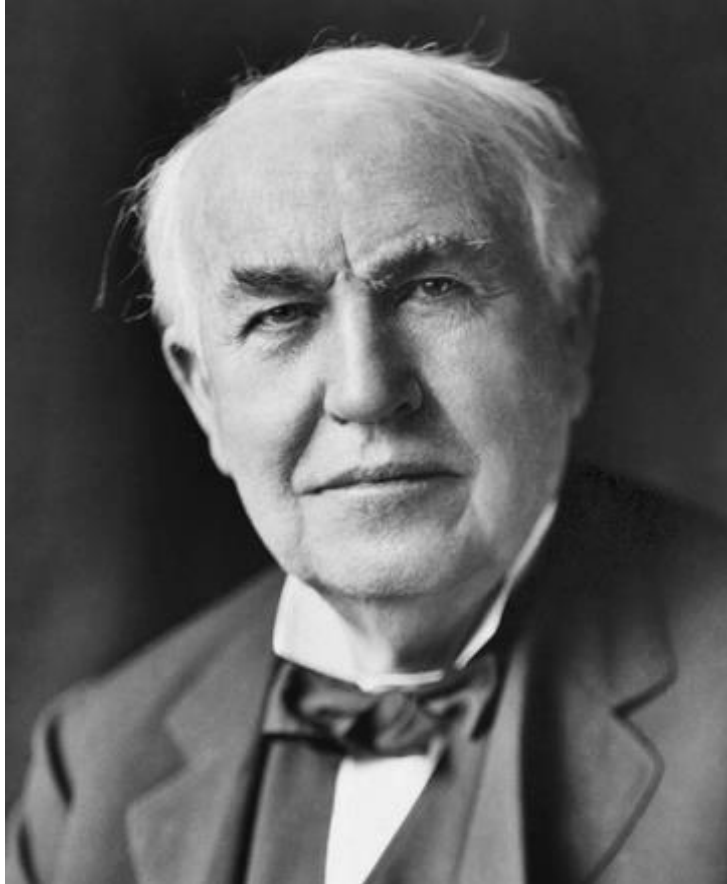


Air Conditioner (1902)



Willis Carrier

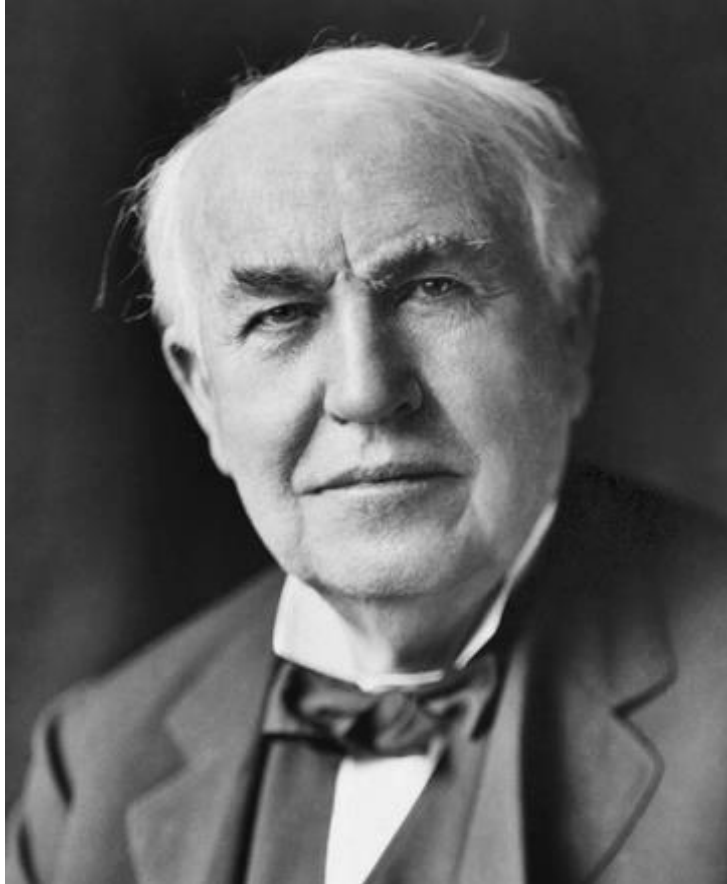
Willis Carrier, American inventor and industrialist who formulated the basic theories of air conditioning. In 1902, while an engineer with the Buffalo Forge Company, Carrier designed the first system to control temperature and humidity. His “Rational Psychrometric Formulae,” introduced in a 1911

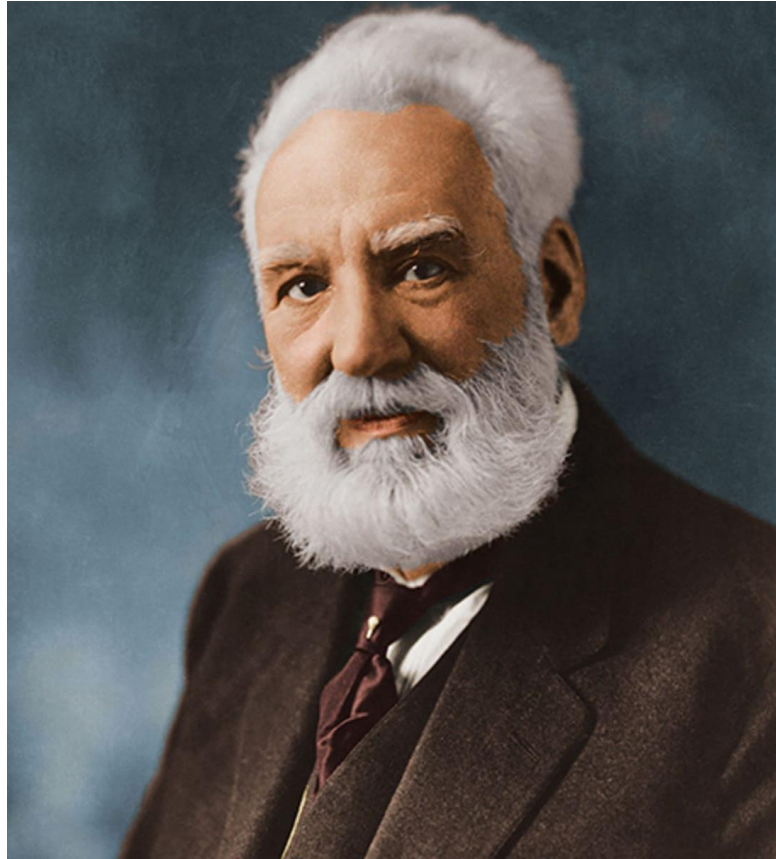


Light Bulb (1878)



Thomas Edison

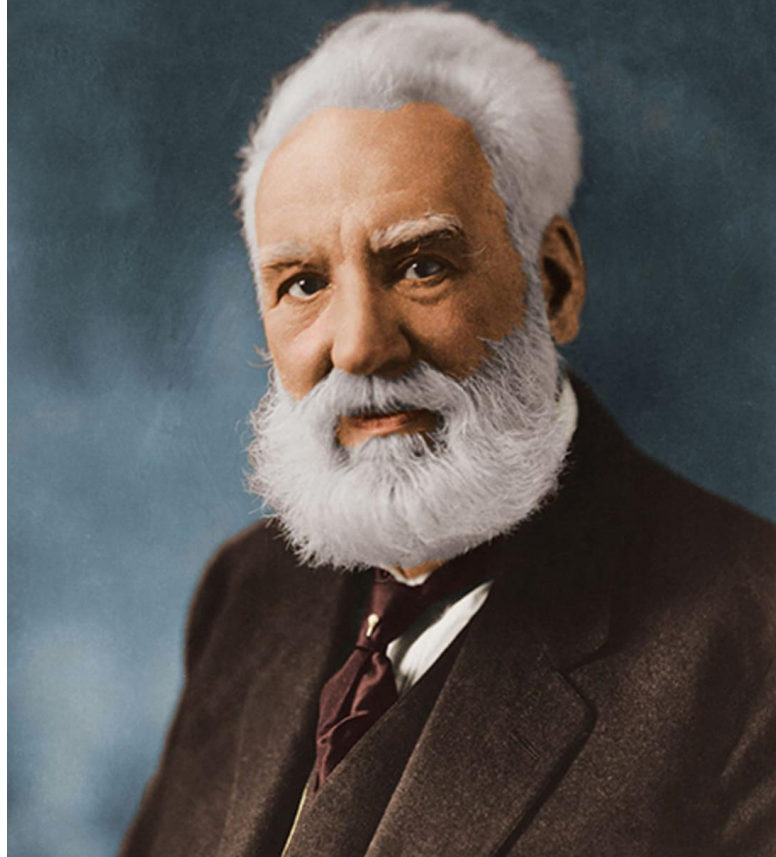
An American inventor and businessman. In 1878, Edison began working on a system of electrical illumination. He began by tackling the problem of creating a long-lasting incandescent lamp, something that would be needed for indoor use. Thomas Edison's first successful model of light bulb, used in public demonstration at Menlo Park, December 1879.

Telephone (1876)



Alexander Graham Bell

He was a Scottish-born inventor, scientist and engineer who is credited with patenting the first practical telephone. His research on hearing and speech further led him to experiment with hearing devices which eventually culminated in Bell being awarded the first U.S. patent for the telephone, on March 7, 1876. Bell considered his invention an intrusion on his real work as a scientist and refused to have a telephone in his study.

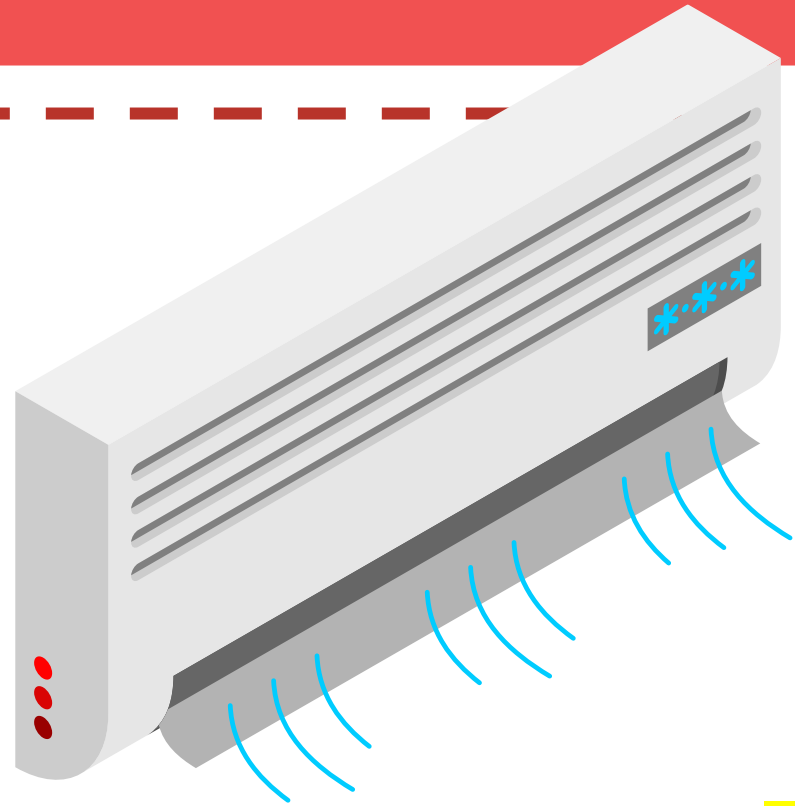

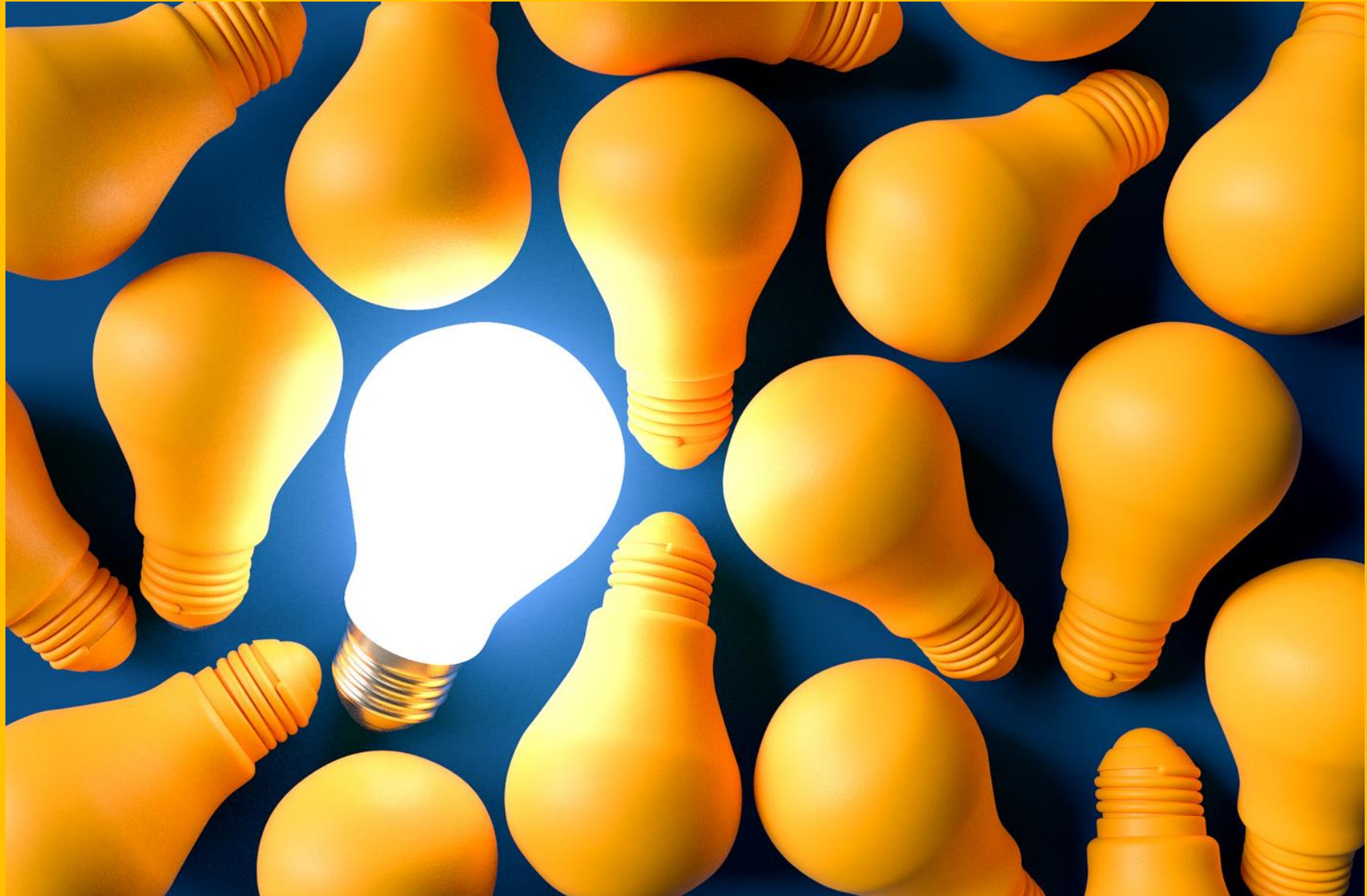

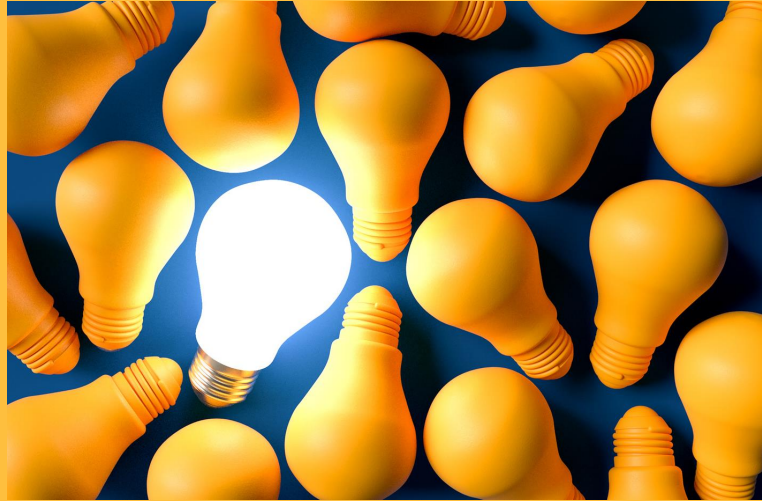
