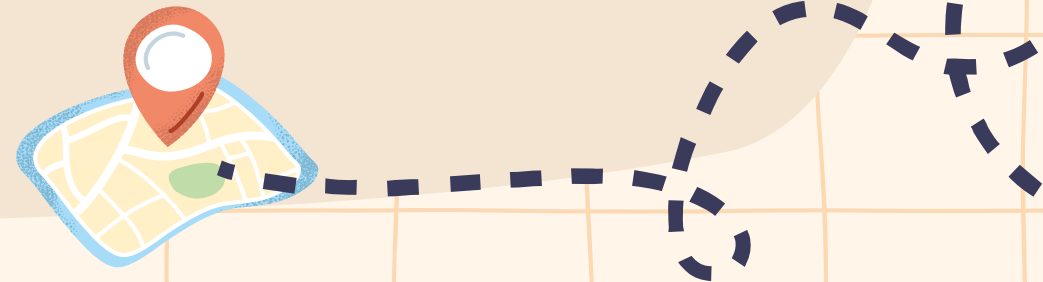

Def.

a place to stay or live



confirmation (n.)

Ex.

She printed the booking confirmation for her flight.



Def.

a statement of proof that something is true



toiletries (n.)

Ex.

I packed my toiletries before leaving for the trip.



Def.

soaps, shampoos, toothpaste, and other items used to keep yourself clean



belongings (n.)

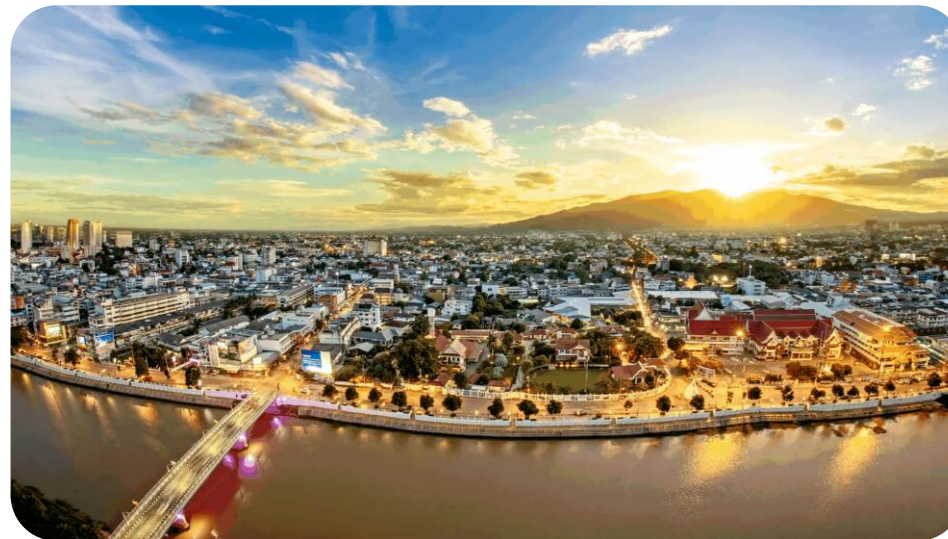

Ex.

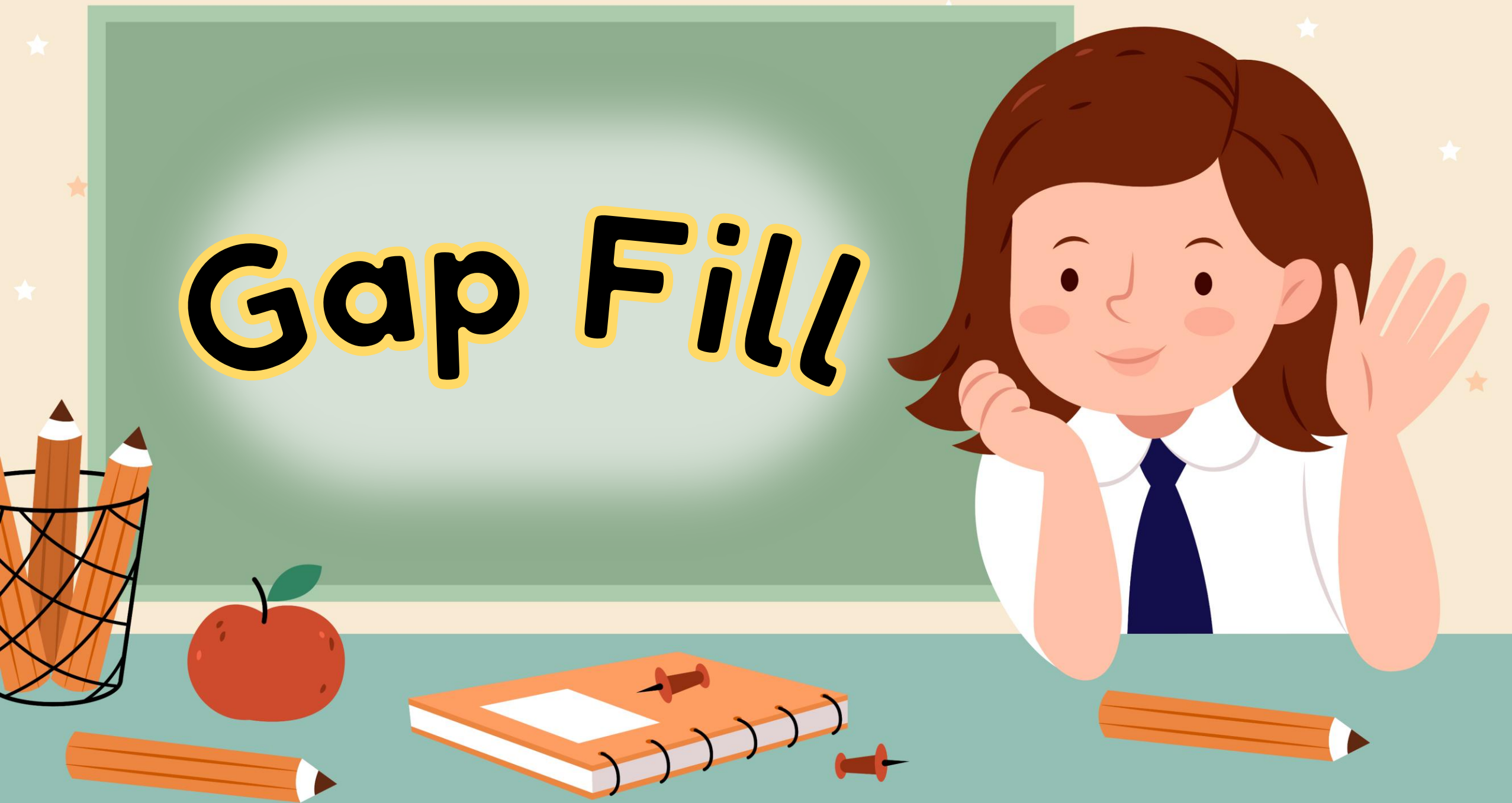
**I booked a domestic flight
