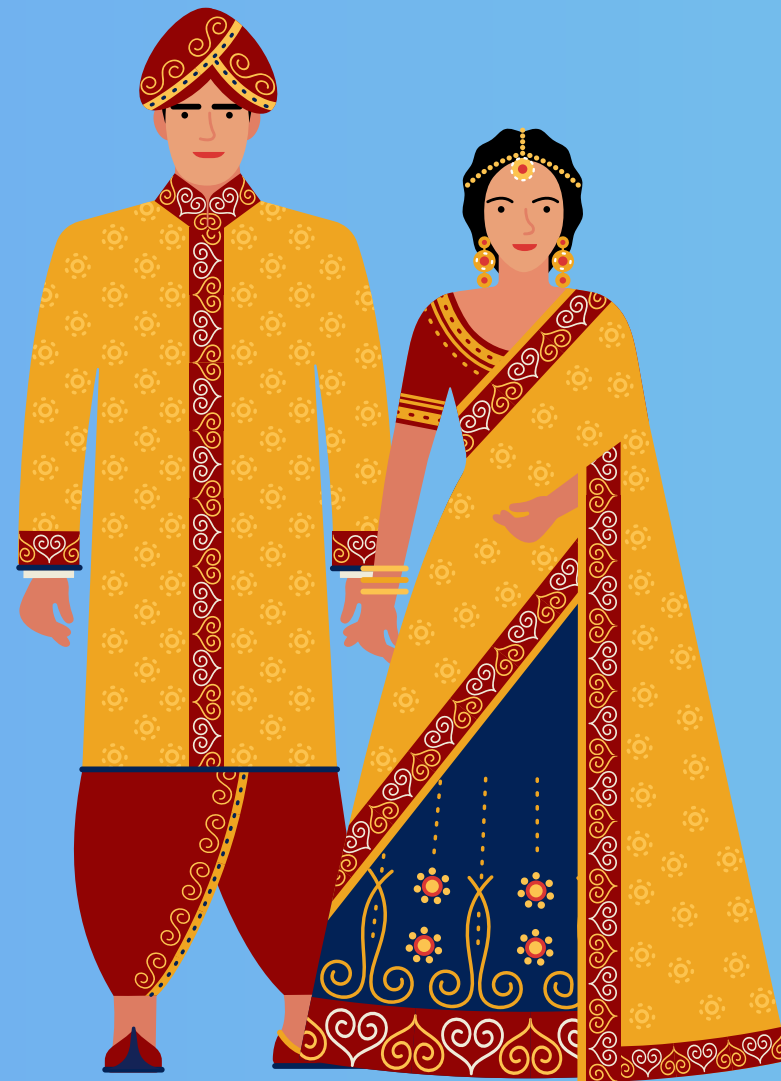

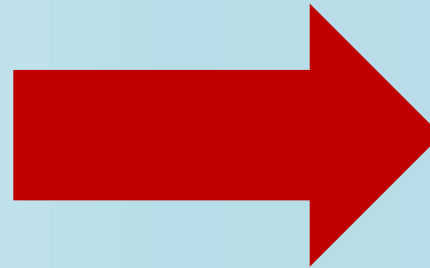

like a party or a holiday



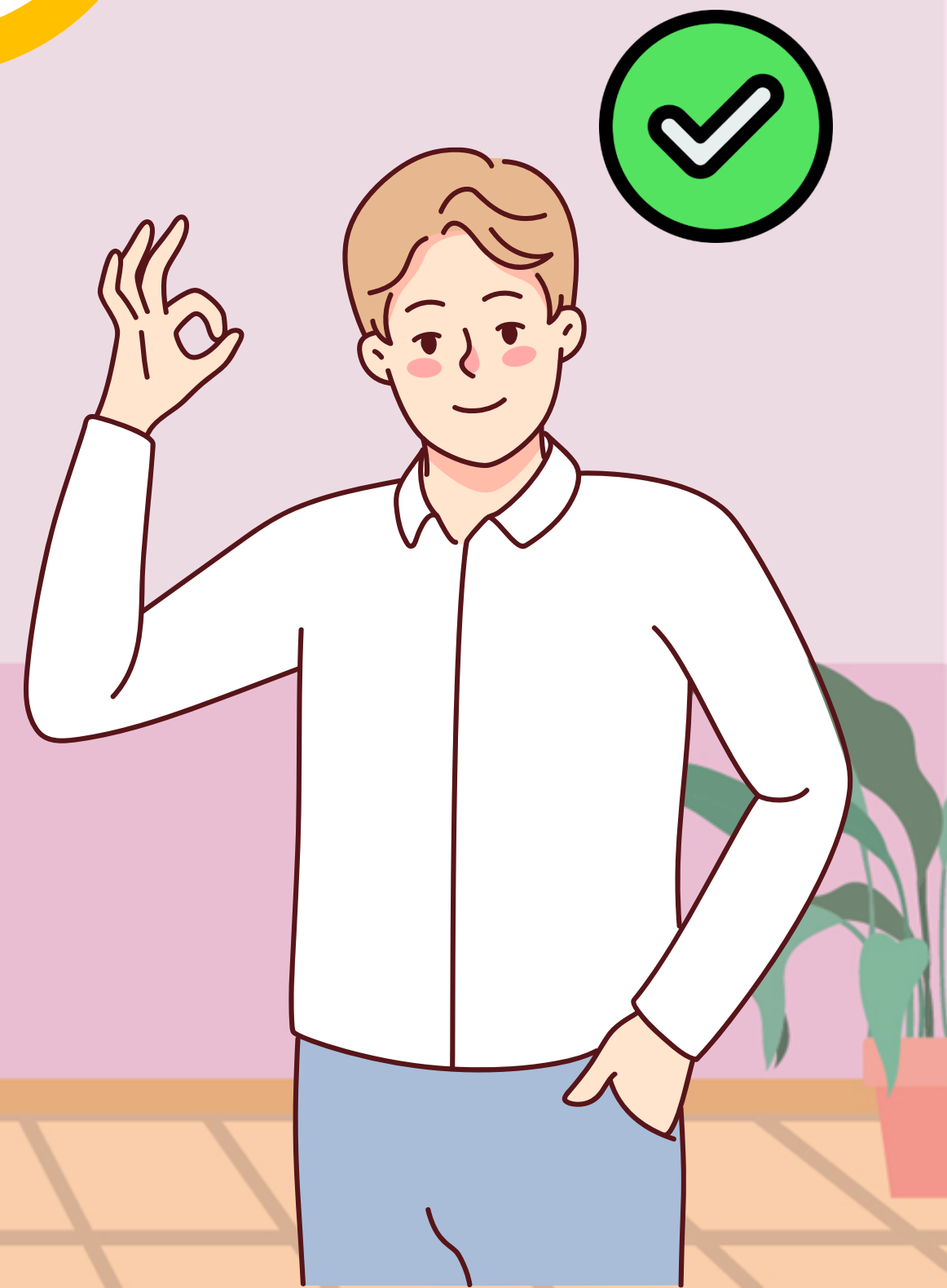
The girl is wearing the traditional Korean dress on her special occasion.

National Costumes

Team A: Korea

The Hanbok is the national dress of the women of Korea which consists of three main components: the Jeogori (a jacket), Hagi (trousers), and Jima (a skirt).

For modern Koreans, Hanbok is formal clothing worn during Korean holidays or on special occasions. Children wear Hanbok on their first birthday and adults wear it for their wedding ceremony or major events within the family, including funerals.





National Costumes

Team B: Russia

The Sarafan and the Poneva are two major types of Russian ethnic dress. The Sarafan is a long dress worn over a long linen shirt and belted. The belt, a necessary component of traditional Russian dress, is often worn under the Sarafan.

For special occasions, they can be made from brocades and silks and embroidered with gold and silver threads.






National Costumes

Team C: India

Traditional Indian clothing may be worn in daily life or for special occasions such as weddings. For women, this consists of a sari, a long piece of cloth usually embroidered or patterned over a simple or fancy blouse. Men wear long sheets of white cloth known as a dhoti over a t-shirt or other comfortable clothing.
