



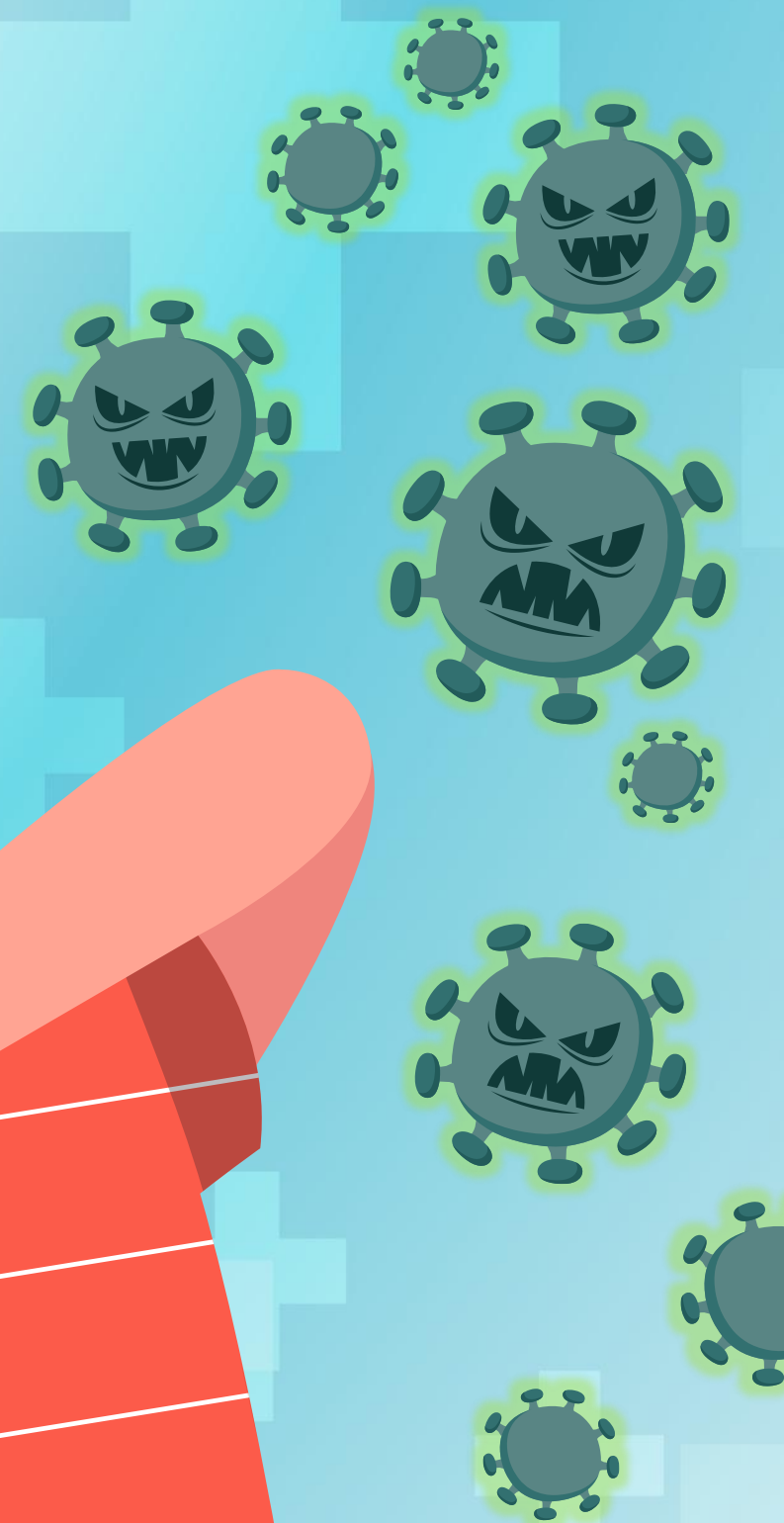

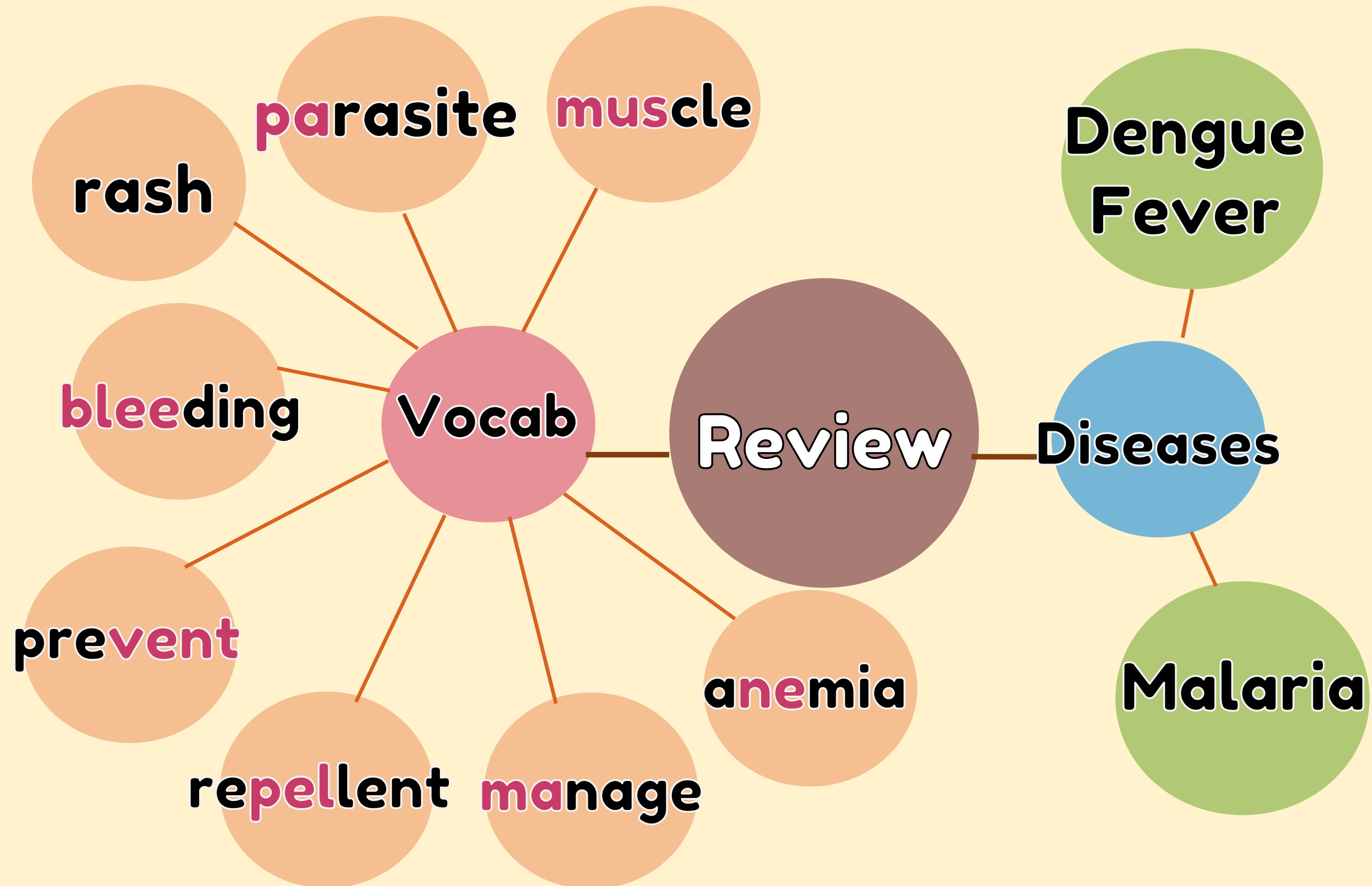

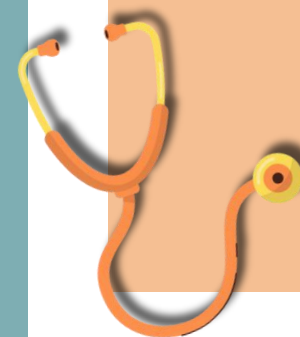




shiver (n.)

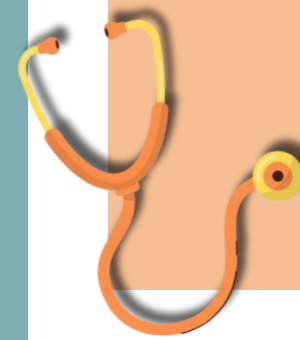

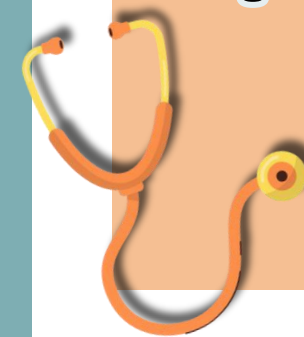

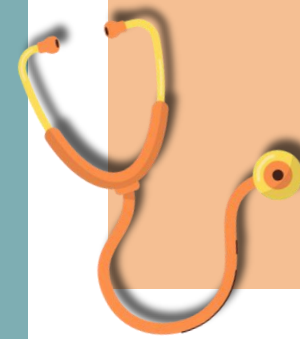

Story A: Aisha

Aisha has a high fever and feels very cold, with chills that make her shiver uncontrollably. She sweats a lot, and the fever seems to come and go in waves. Along with the fever, Aisha has a headache, feels nauseous, and sometimes vomits. Her muscles are sore, and she feels extremely tired.

Story B: John

John, a 35-year-old office worker, began to feel unwell one day with a high fever of 38.5°C (101.3°F) and a persistent dry cough. The next day, he was extremely tired, with body aches making it hard to move. By the third day, he noticed he couldn't taste or smell his breakfast and his throat was sore. On the fourth day, John found it difficult to breathe and had a constant headache that wouldn't go away. The following day, he experienced chills, shivering even under a blanket, and his nose became congested and runny.

Story C: Carlos

Carlos is a 28-year-old man who lives in a tropical city. One day, he starts feeling very unwell. He has a high fever and a severe headache that makes it hard to concentrate. His eyes hurt, especially when he looks around. Carlos also feels pain in his muscles and joints, which is so bad it feels like his bones are breaking. 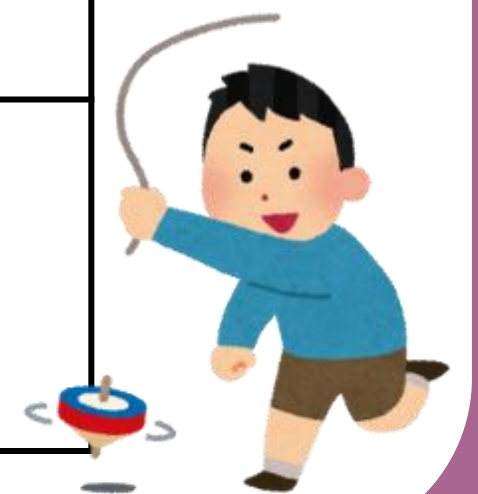
