Conditional Sentence Type 1

If he exercises everyday, he will lose weight.

If + S + V1 , S + will + Vinf

He will lose weight if he exercises everyday.

S + will + Vinf if + S + V1

**** If the condition is true, the result will likely happen.**

Conditional Sentence Type 2

If I were a living toy, I would travel everywhere.

condition

result

If + S + **V₂** , S + **would + V_{inf}**



I would travel everywhere if I were a living toy.

result

condition

S + **would + V_{inf}** if + S + **V₂**

Conditional Sentence Type 3

If they had invited me, I would have gone.

If + S + **had V₃** , S + **would have + V₃**

I would have gone if they had invited me.

S + **would have + V₃** if + S + **had V₃**

Conditional Sentence Type 3

If they had invited me, I would have gone.

If + S + had V₃ , S + would have + V₃

I would have gone if they had invited me.

S + would have + V₃ if + S + had V₃



