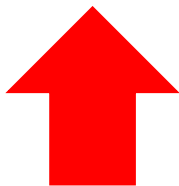

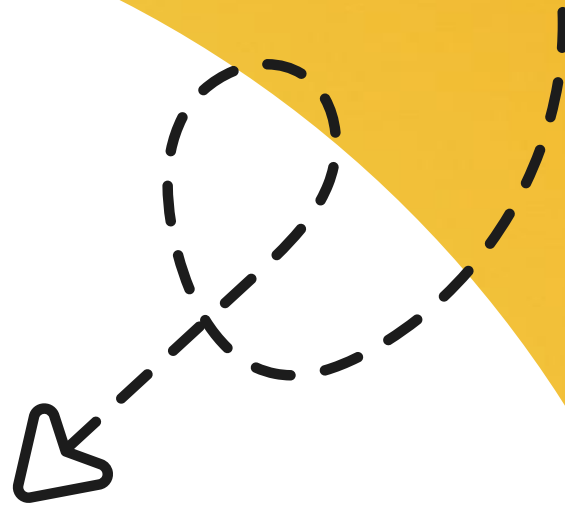
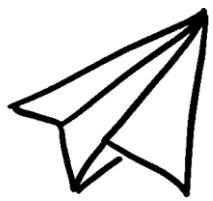

# Adventure

**Games that focus on *exploring* and solving puzzles.**

- **Example: "The Legend of Zelda"**

**Games that require careful planning and thinking to achieve victory.**

- o **Example: "Civilization"**



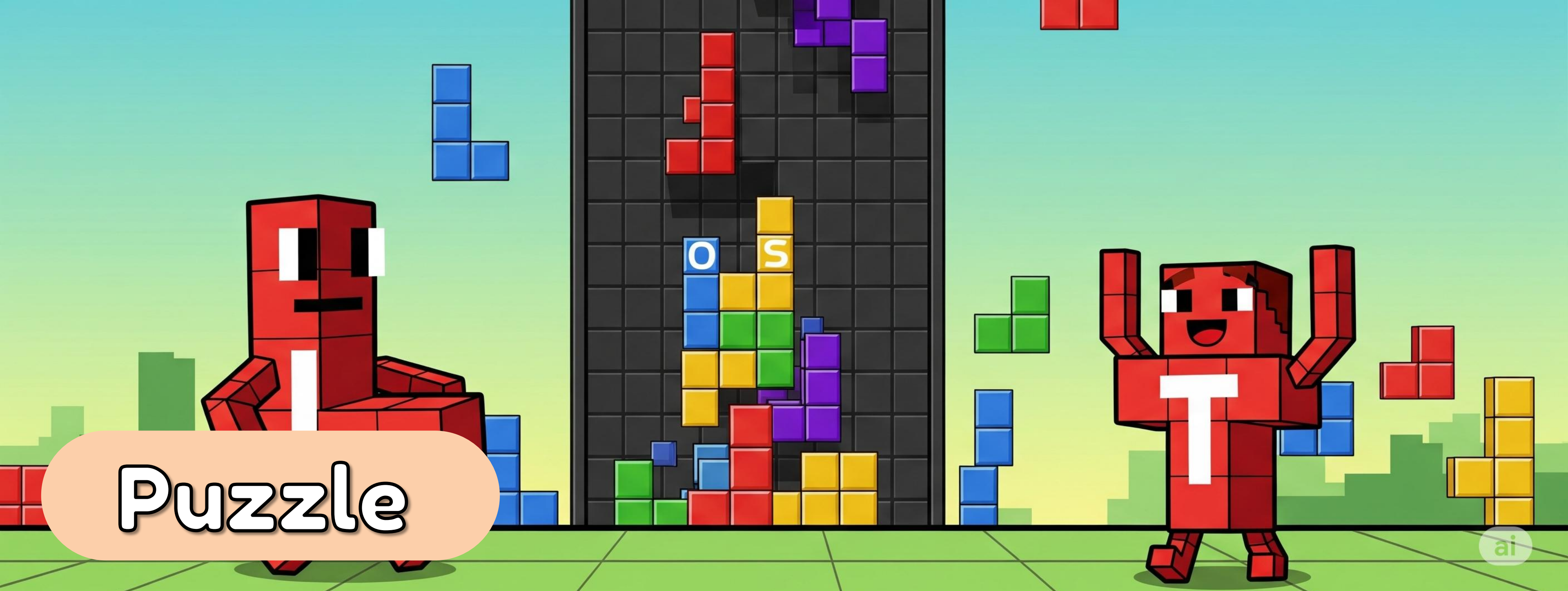


# Sports

**Games that simulate playing sports.**

Puzzle

**Games that challenge the player's problem-solving skills.**

# Shooter

Games that focus on **shooting enemies** or targets.

- Example: "Call of Duty"

- **Example: "Minecraft"**





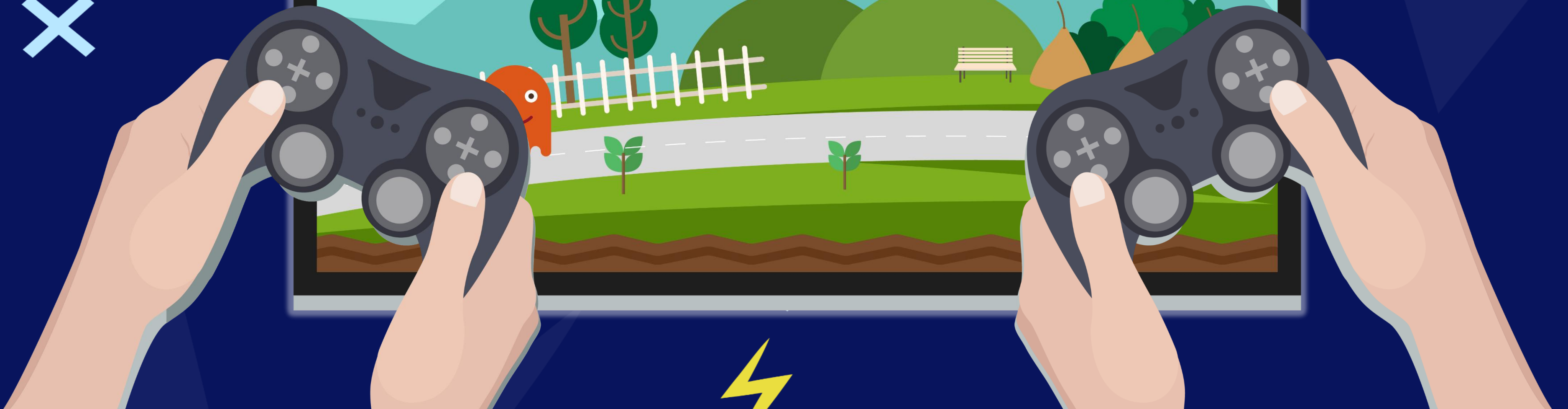

**V** to have + **V** 3/ed

**S + had + V 3/ed**

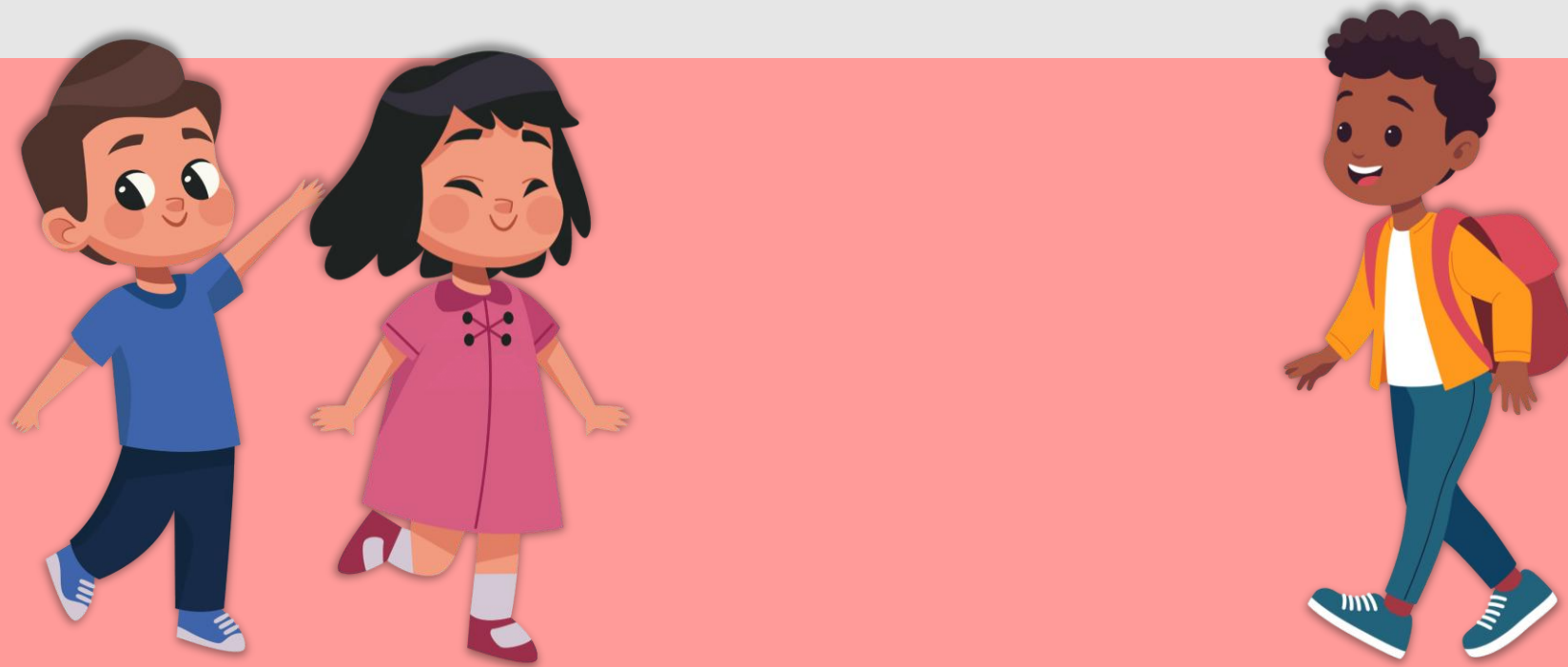

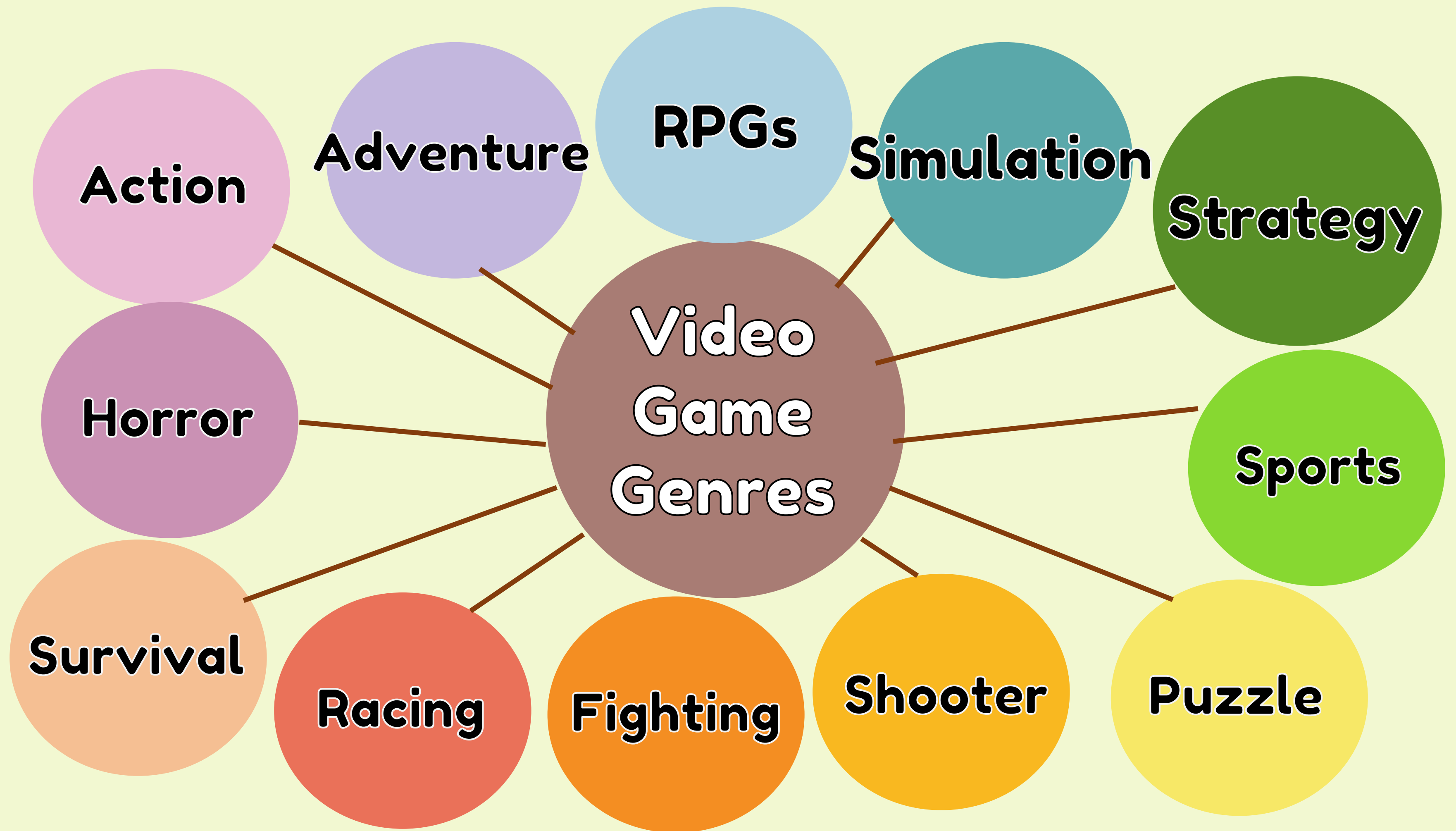
