#### Buddha statues (n.)



Sculptures or images that represent the Buddha, who is the founder of Buddhism. They remind people of his teachings, peace, compassion, and enlightenment:

- People worship Buddha statues at the temple.
- People believe Buddha statues bring peace and good luck.


## pour water (phr.v.)



To make water flow from a container, such as a cup, bottle, or bowl:

- People pour water on Buddha statues as part of the New Year ceremony in Thailand.
- During Songkran, people pour water on Buddha statues to show respect.

## make merit (phr.v.)



To do good deeds to gain positive karma or spiritual benefit, especially by doing kind actions or religious activities:

#### Examples

Many families make merit together at the temple on special days.

She makes merit by offering food to monks at the temple.

## offer food (phr.v.)



To give food to someone politely or respectfully — often to monks, guests, or during a religious ceremony:

- We offer food to monks to show kindness and respect.
- You can offer food to monks by giving rice, fruit, or drinks.

## have a water fight (phr.v.)



To play by throwing or splashing water at each other for fun:

- Let's have a water fight and cool off in the hot weather!
- Children love to have a water fight with their friends.

## get soaked (phr.v.)



To become completely wet, usually from rain or water:

- The students get soaked when they play sports in the rain.
- Don't forget your raincoat, or you'll get soaked on the way home!

## pay respect (phr.v.)



To show honor, admiration, or politeness to someone — especially to elders, teachers, or important people:

- It is a Thai tradition to pay respect to elders on special occasions.
- We should always pay respect to elders and listen to their advice.

## ask for blessings (phr.v.)

May this Thai New Year bring you happiness, good health, and prosperity.



To request good wishes, good luck, or protection—usually from elders, monks, or holy persons.

- Many people ask for blessings during the New Year festival.
- ❖ Lask for blessings from my parents before an important exam.

#### atmosphere (n.)



The feeling that exists in a place or situation.

- The festival brings a joyful atmosphere to the town.
- The restaurant offers a romantic atmosphere for couples.



## ask for blessings (phr.v.)

May this Thai New Year bring you happiness, good health, and prosperity.



To request good wishes, good luck, or protection—usually from elders, monks, or holy persons.






