Demonstrative Pronouns (คำสรรพนามชี้เฉพาะ)

Demonstrative Pronouns are used to point out specific people or things in a sentence.

Here are some examples.

Pronouns	Example	Functions
This	This is my shopping bag.	Refers to a singular object that is close to the speaker
That	That is a can of tuna.	Refers to a singular object that is far from the speaker
These	These are bottles of water.	Refers to multiple objects that are close to the speaker
Those	Those are bags of sugar.	Refers to multiple objects that are far from the speaker



Demonstrative Determiners (คำนำหน้านามชี้เฉพาะ)

Demonstrative Determiners are used to point out specific people or things and show their relative position or distance from the speaker.

Here are some examples.

Determiners	Example
This	This cake is delicious.
That	That salmon is quite expensive.
These	These apples are fresh.
Those	Those cookies are homemade.



Using **This, That, These, Those** in the Supermarket

Demonstrative words.	Example
This	This egg is fresh.
That	That chocolate is sweet.
These	These apples are red.
Those	those oranges are big.
