Vocabulary



vacation (n)

A period of time when you are not at home but are staying somewhere else for enjoyment:

Examples



- ❖ I'm planning to go to the beach for my next **vacation**.
- ❖ Many students like to travel abroad during their school **vacation**.

founder (n)

Someone who establishes an organization:

Examples

- ❖ The **founder** believed that education could change the world.
- ❖ She dreams of becoming the **founder** of her own company one day.



suffer (v)

To experience pain or unpleasant emotions:

Examples

- ❖ He **suffered** a serious injury during the football match.
- ❖ She **suffered** from a bad cold last week.



persecution (n)

The unfair or cruel treatment of someone, especially because of their race, religion, or beliefs:

Examples

- ❖ Human rights groups work to stop **persecution** around the world.
- ❖ Many people left their homeland to escape **persecution**.



pilgrim (n)

Someone who travels to a place that is important in their religion:

Examples

- ❖ Many **pilgrims** visit temples in Thailand during important festivals.
- ❖ A **pilgrim** is a person who travels to a holy place for religious reasons.





harvest (n)

The time when crops are cut and collected from fields:



Examples

- ❖ The **harvest** was very good this year.
- ❖ After the **harvest**, they celebrated with music and dance.

governor (n)

Someone who is officially responsible for controlling a region, city, or organization:

Examples

- ❖ The **governor** is responsible for developing the province.
- ❖ The **governor** gave a speech about public safety.





colony (n)

A country or area controlled in an official, political way by a more powerful country:



Examples

- ❖ Thailand was never a **colony** of any European country.
- ❖ The British Empire had many **colonies** around the world.

traditional (adj)

Following the customs or ways of behaving that have continued in a group of people or society for a long time:

Examples

- ❖ My grandmother cooks **traditional** Thai food for our family.
- ❖ Many young people still follow **traditional** customs.
