# Vocabulary





# ornament (n)

An attractive object that is used as a decoration in a home or garden:



## Examples

- ❖ Each **ornament** on the tree has a special meaning.
- ❖ My mother bought new glass **ornaments** for this year's Christmas.

# gingerbread (n)

A type of cake or cookie that contains ginger:



## Examples

- ❖ The **gingerbread** smells delicious.
- ❖ I love eating **gingerbread** at Christmas.



# wreath (n)

A wreath is a circle of flowers, leaves, or other materials that people use as a decoration or to show respect (for example, at Christmas or at a funeral):



## Examples

- ❖ My mom made a beautiful **wreath** with ribbons and pine cones.
- ❖ We hung a Christmas **wreath** on the door.



# tinsel (n)

Long pieces of thin, shiny material used as decoration, especially at Christmas:



## Examples

- ❖ The **tinsel** sparkled in the light.
- ❖ My little brother wrapped **tinsel** around his head like a crown.



# mistletoe (n)

An evergreen plant (= one that never loses its leaves) that grows on trees, with small, white fruits and pale yellow flowers. Mistletoe is often used as a Christmas decoration, and it is traditional to kiss someone under it:



## Examples

- ❖ We hung **mistletoe** above the door at Christmas.
- ❖ People believe that kissing under the **mistletoe** brings love.



# mince pie (n)

A mince pie is a small round pie filled with a sweet mixture of dried fruits, spices, sugar, and sometimes nuts, called mincemeat:



## Examples

- ❖ We always eat **mince pies** on Christmas Eve.
- ❖ My grandmother makes delicious homemade **mince pies**.



# chimney (n)

a hollow structure that allows the smoke from a fire inside a building to escape to the air outside:



## Examples

- ❖ Santa Claus comes down the **chimney** on Christmas Eve.
- ❖ Smoke is coming out of the **chimney**.



# candy cane (n)

A piece of flavoured hard candy shaped like a cane  
(= a walking stick)



## Examples

- ❖ Children love eating **candy canes** at Christmas.
- ❖ The **candy cane** is shaped like the letter “J” for Jesus.



# leave out (phr. v.)

To not include someone or something:



## Examples

- ❖ Please **leave out** the onions; I don't like them.
- ❖ Children like to **leave out** cookies and milk for Santa.

**Why is Christmas Celebrated?** Christmas is celebrated by Christians all around the world every year. It is a day for Christians who believe in Christmas story and the birth of Jesus who was the son of God.

**When is Christmas Day?** Christmas day is on the 25<sup>th</sup> of December every year. It is the tradition which full of joy, happiness and goodness.

**Christmas Cards** - People like to write Christmas cards to each other and sent them during December. They often say 'Merry Christmas' and have lots of picture on them.

**Decorations** - People like to decorate their

home with Christmas decorations, such as candles, wreaths and paper chains. Christmas trees are put up downstairs in homes and can be decorated with gifts, baubles, fairy light, tinsel, mistletoe and a star or angel on the top.

**Letters to Santa** - Santa Claus with white beard, also known as Father of Christmas, Saint Nick, Kris Kringle, or simply Santa. Some children like to write letters to Santa, telling him how good they've been and what they would like for Christmas.

**Christmas Eve** - Christmas Eve is the day before Christmas. It is a very exciting day! Some families like to leave out a mince pie and drink for Santa, along with some carrots for the reindeer. Sometimes, if they don't have a chimney, children like to leave out a magic key for Santa.

**Christmas Day** - Families and friends like to spend time together to celebrate Christmas Day in all sorts of different ways. They wish and hope for the best to their families. Many families open their gifts and have a special meal with crackers to pull. Some Christians like to attend the church to celebrate Jesus's birthday – the church ring their bells on this special day.

**Christmas Food** - Families prepare their favorite foods over the Christmas holidays. Lots of people like eating turkey, goose, Christmas puddings, mince pies, gingerbread and candy canes. Delicious!

**Boxing day** - The day after Christmas is also a holiday. It's known as Boxing Day. There are lots of items on sale for people who love going shopping!
