

# firework (n)

Bright, colorful lights that explode in the sky:



- We watched the fireworks light up the night sky on New Year's Eve.
- Taking photos of fireworks is difficult because they move so fast.

# celebrate (v)

To do something special for an event or holiday:



- My family always celebrates birthdays with a big dinner.
- The town celebrates its founding day every April with a parade.

# resolution (n)

A promise or goal you make for the new year:

I will study harder.

- My New Year's resolution is to study English every day.
- She made a resolution to exercise more often.

# countdown (n)

An act of counting backwards to zero:



- The countdown to the New Year started at ten.
- The crowd shouted together during the countdown.

# firecrackers (n)

Small explosives that make loud bangs during festivals.



- People lit firecrackers to celebrate the New Year.
- The teacher told the students not to play with firecrackers.

# lantern (n)


A festival light or lamp, often used in celebrations:



- The glowing lanterns looked beautiful at night.
- Many tourists came to see the lantern festival in Chiang Mai.

# envelope (n)

A paper container used to hold letters or money:



- He gave me a red envelope for New Year.
- The teacher handed out envelopes to all students.

# put up (v)

## To hang or place decorations:



- We put up a New Year poster in our classroom.
- They put up colorful lights around the school.
