
# priest (n)

A priest is a person who works in a religious place (like a church or temple) and leads prayers, ceremonies, and rituals.



## Examples

- ❖ The priest led the prayer in the church.
- ❖ The priest helps the community with ceremonies like weddings and funerals.




# emperor (n)

An emperor is a male ruler of an empire, which is usually a very large group of countries or territories. He has the highest power in the land.



## Examples

- ❖ The emperor ruled over many lands.
- ❖ People respected the emperor because of his power.



# get married (phr.v.)


To have a wedding and become husband and wife  
(or partners in marriage).



## Examples

❖ She is going to get married next month.

❖ They are getting married in December.





# romance (n)

A love relationship or a feeling of love between two people — especially when it is sweet, emotional, or dreamy.

## Examples

- ❖ This movie is a romance about two people who meet in Paris.
- ❖ She likes reading romance novels before bed.






# Invitation (n)

A request to ask someone to come to an event, party, wedding, meeting, or special occasion.

## Examples

- ❖ I sent an invitation to all my friends.
- ❖ Thank you for the invitation to your party!






# army (n)

A military force that has the training and equipment to fight on land:



## Examples

- ❖ The army protects the nation.
- ❖ The priest helps the community with ceremonies like weddings and funerals.




# admire (v)

To admire someone or something means to look at them with respect, appreciation, or praise, especially because you think they are good, beautiful, brave, or talented.




## Examples

- ❖ I admire my parents. They always work hard for me.
- ❖ They admire her for her kindness.



# agree (v)

To have the same opinion or to say yes to something.



## Examples

- ❖ He always says “yes” just to agree with everyone.
- ❖ I agree with your opinion.
