Vocabulary



pollution (n)

Damage caused to water, air, etc. by harmful substances or waste:



Examples

- ❖ Plastic **pollution** is a serious problem in the ocean.
- ❖ Water **pollution** can harm fish and other animals.

environment (n)

The air, water, and land in or on which people, animals, and plants live:

Examples

- ❖ We must protect the **environment** for future generations.
- ❖ Throwing trash on the ground harms the **environment**.



release (v)

To allow a substance to flow out from somewhere:

Examples

- ❖ Factories sometimes **release** smoke into the air.
- ❖ The company will **release** clean water after treatment.



chemical (adj)

Of, involved with, relating to, or made by using chemicals or chemistry:

Examples

- ❖ Factories should treat their chemical waste before releasing it in to rivers.
- ❖ The farmer used a chemical spray to protect his crops from insects.

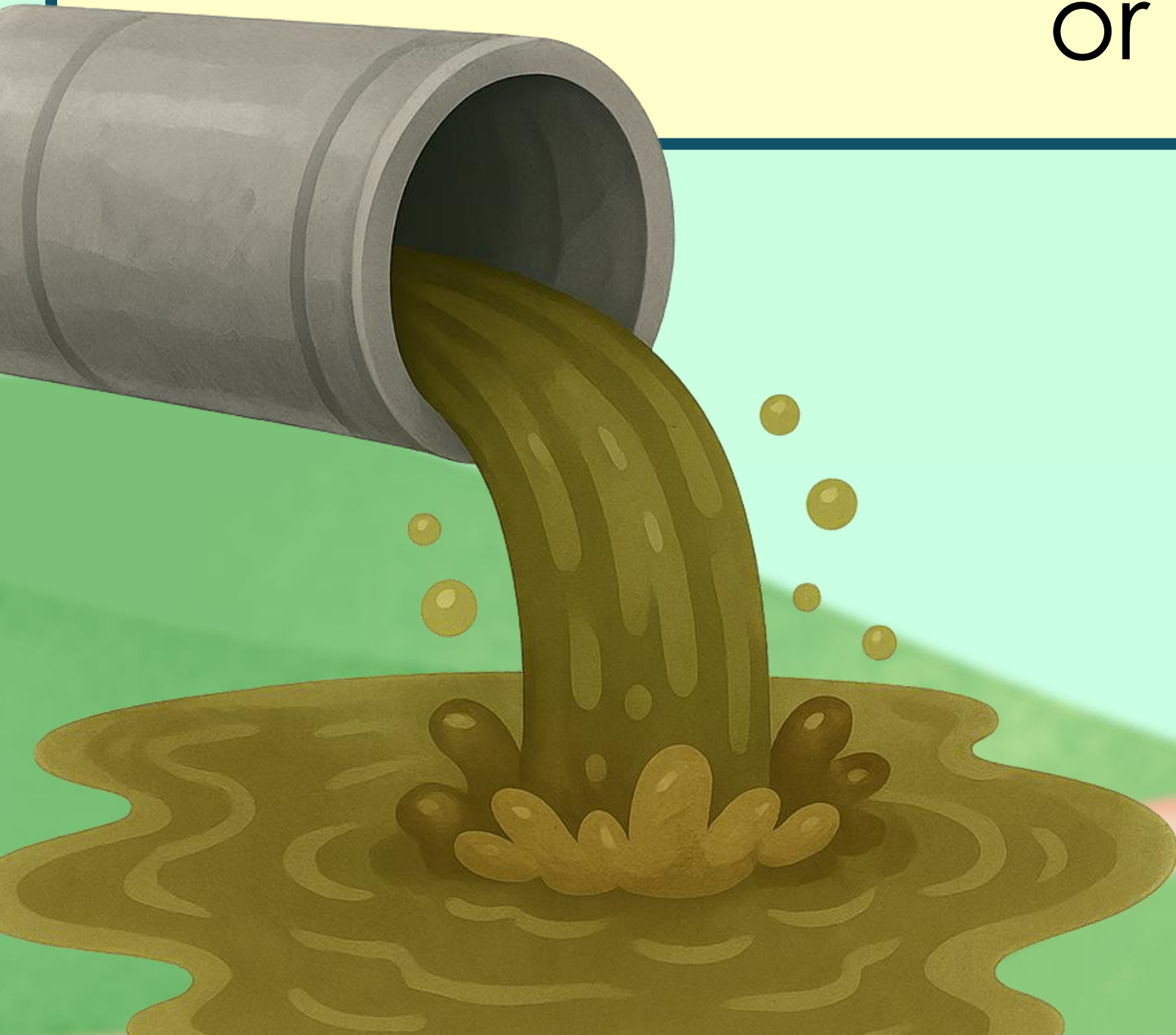


sewage (n)

Waste matter such as water or human urine or solid waste:

Examples

- ❖ Dirty **sewage** flows into the river.
- ❖ **Sewage** can cause diseases if not treated properly.



pesticide (n)

A chemical substance used to kill harmful insects, small animals, wild plants, and other unwanted organisms:

Examples

- ❖ Farmers use **pesticides** to protect their crops.
- ❖ Eating vegetables with **pesticide** residue is unhealthy.



garbage (n)

Waste material or unwanted things that you throw away:

Examples

- ❖ People should throw **garbage** in the trash bin.
- ❖ Burning **garbage** creates toxic smoke.



landfill (n)

A place where garbage is buried:

Examples

- ❖ The city opened a new **landfill** to manage waste.
- ❖ Many countries are running out of **landfill** space.



construction (n)

The work of building or making something, especially buildings, bridges, etc.:

Examples

- ❖ The **construction** of the new building is very noisy.
- ❖ **Construction** sites must follow safety rules.



increase (v)

To become or make something larger or greater:

Examples

- ❖ Pollution levels **increase** every year.
- ❖ Recycling can **increase** environmental awareness.
