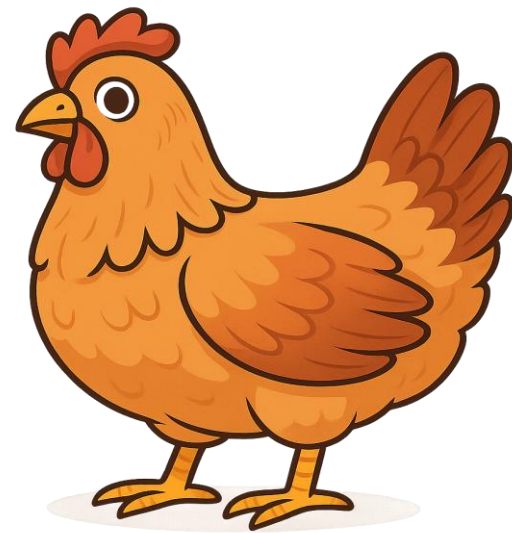

You say your friend's word.



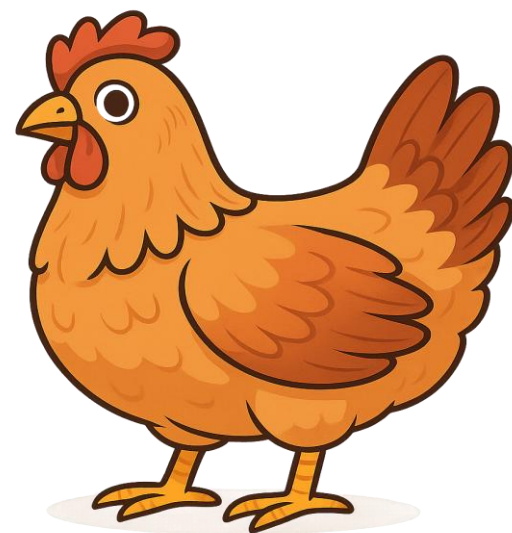

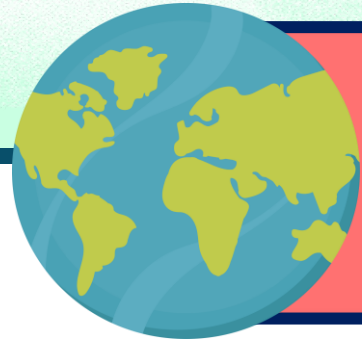

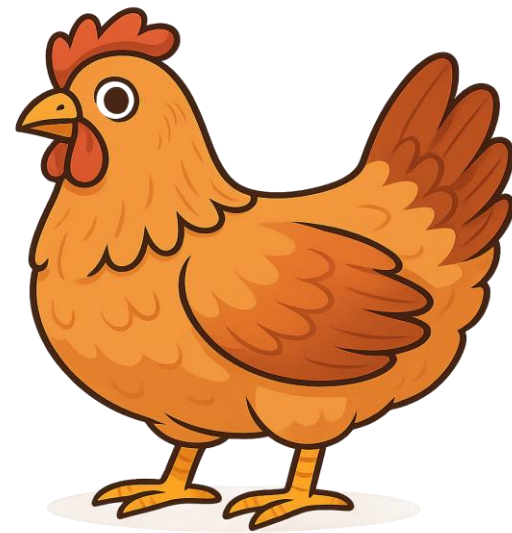
- 👉 You say your friend's word.

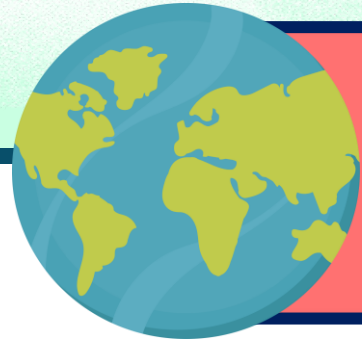

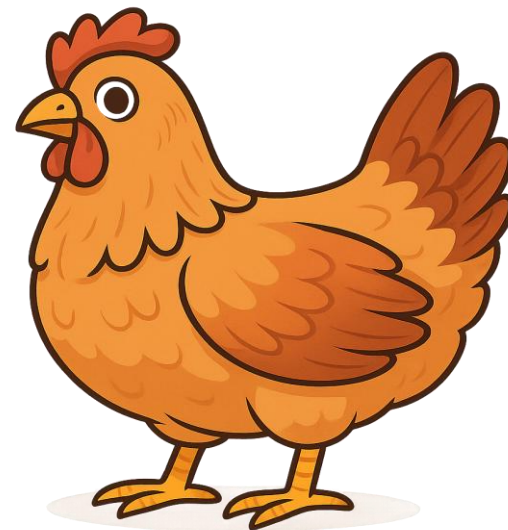

Must



When Do We Use “Must”?

Something you must do because
the speaker says so / the speaker
thinks it is important.



When Do We Use “Must”?

Strong obligation

- ❖ You **must** finish your homework.
- ❖ She **must** speak English in the classroom.
- ❖ He **must** drink enough water every day.
- ❖ You **must** arrive at school on time.
- ❖ You **must** wash your hands before eating.



When Do We Use “Must”?

Strong Command

- ❖ You **must** stop talking right now!
- ❖ He **must** go to the principal's office!
- ❖ They **must** clean the classroom now!
- ❖ We **must** follow the teacher's instructions!
- ❖ The students **must** pay attention!



When Do We Use “Must”?

Strong Advice

- ❖ You **must** drink more water.
- ❖ You **must** try this new study method.
- ❖ He **must** take a break; he looks exhausted.
- ❖ You **must** get enough sleep.



When Do We Use “Must”?

Strong Certainty (Almost Sure)

- ❖ He **must** be sick; he didn't come to school today.
- ❖ You **must** be hungry; you haven't eaten anything.
- ❖ She **must** really love animals.
- ❖ Everyone **must** be confused by the new rules.



Mustn't



When Do We Use “Mustn’t”?

Rules and prohibitions

- ❖ You **mustn’t** run in the hallway.
- ❖ Students **mustn’t** use phones during the exam.
- ❖ You **mustn’t** eat in the classroom.



When Do We Use “Mustn’t”?

Dangerous situations

- ❖ You **mustn’t** touch the hot stove.
- ❖ You **mustn’t** cross the road without looking.
- ❖ You **mustn’t** swim alone.



Has to / Have to



When Do We Use “has to / have to”?

We use has to / have to **to talk about things that are necessary, rules, or duties.**



When Do We Use “has to / have to”?

1. Obligation or necessity

Used when something is necessary because of a situation.

- ❖ I **have to** wake up early tomorrow.
- ❖ You **have to** drink more water every day.
- ❖ She **has to** take her medicine after meals.
- ❖ They **have to** study for the exam.



When Do We Use “has to / have to”?

2. Rules and laws

Used when a rule tells you what you must do.

- ❖ Students **have to** wear a school uniform.
- ❖ Drivers **have to** stop at the red light.
- ❖ You **have to** show your ID at the airport.
- ❖ Passengers **have to** wear seatbelts.



When Do We Use “has to / have to”?

3. Responsibilities

Used when someone has a duty to do something.

- ❖ I **have to** take care of my little brother.
- ❖ She **has to** finish her project today.
- ❖ He **has to** help his parents at home.
- ❖ We **have to** clean the classroom every Friday.



**Don't have to
Doesn't have to**



Don't have to/Doesn't have to

👉 There is NO obligation.

👉 You can choose to do it or not.

👉 It is OK if you don't do it.

Don't have to

- ❖ You **don't have to** bring your laptop today.
- ❖ They **don't have to** wear a uniform on Friday.
- ❖ We **don't have to** hurry; we have a lot of time.
- ❖ I **don't have to** cook dinner tonight.
- ❖ You **don't have to** pay for this — it's free.

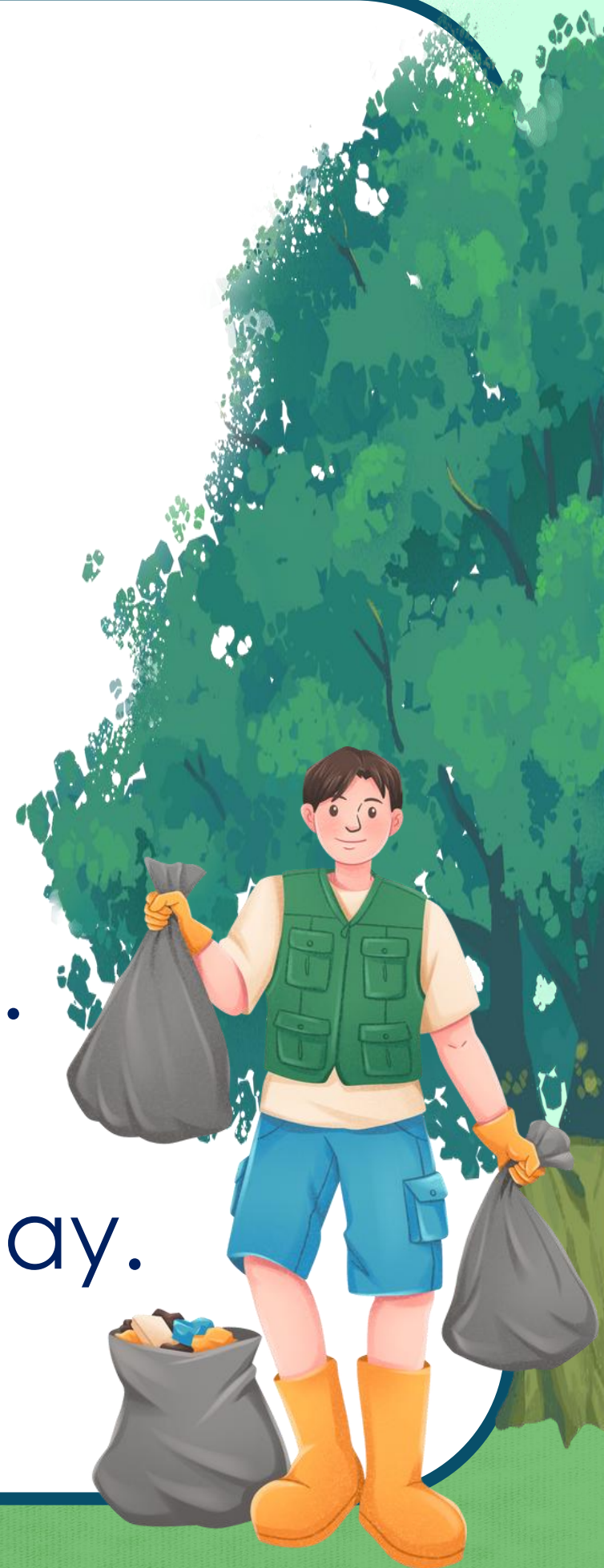


Doesn't have to

- ❖ She **doesn't have to** wake up early on Sundays.
- ❖ He **doesn't have to** go to school tomorrow.
- ❖ My mom **doesn't have to** work at the weekend.
- ❖ The teacher **doesn't have to** check the test today.
