4.____ scenario (n)	d. To continue to be quiet, peaceful, and not worried, especially in a difficult or frightening situation.
5.____ immediately (adv)	e. Falling or moving to a lower level
6.____ sinking (adj)	f. Of or about the mind, or involving the process of thinking.
7.____ plenty (n)	g. A belt that fastens around you when you are travelling in a vehicle or aircraft and holds you in your seat, in order to reduce the risk of being injured in an accident.
8.____ stay calm (phrv)	h. Now or without waiting or thinking.
9.____ mental (adj.)	i. To release the buckle (= metal fastener) of a shoe, belt, etc. so that you can remove it.
