Last year, did you celebrate Loy Krathong?

Yes, I did.





Last Loy Krathong, I **made** a big krathong by myself. I **tried** to float it on the river, but it **tipped over** immediately! All my flowers and candle **fell into** the water. My friends **laughed** so much and I **laughed** too.

Verb Phrase (กริยาวลี)

tipped over - พลิกตะแคง / คว่ำ / ล้ม

fell into - ตกลงไปใน / หล่นลงไปใน

Did your krathong float away or sink immediately?

Verb Phrase (กริยาวลี)

float away - ลอยจากไป / ลอยห่างออกไป /
ลอยไปไกลจนพ้นสายตา



Irregular Verb (กริยา)

sink - จม / จมลงไปในน้ำ

Past Simple Tense

Past Simple Tense is used to talk about events, activities, or situations that happened and were completed in the past.

ประโยคบอกเล่า (Positive) Subject + Verb2 (Past form) + Object

- I decorated krathong by myself last November.

ประโยคปฏิเสธ (Negative) Subject + did not (didn't) + Verb1 + Object

- I didn't go to the parade yesterday.

ประโยคคำถาม (Question) Did + Subject + Verb1 + Object?

- Did you watch the fireworks last December?



Present Simple:

I **make** a krathong **every year**.

Past Simple:

I **made** a krathong **last year**.

Verb Forms

Base form : make = V.1

Past Simple: made = V.2

Past Participle: made = V.3

Adverbs of Time

every year

last year

yesterday

last Loy Krathong



Present Simple

ใช้กล่าวถึงสิ่งที่ทำเป็นประจำ / เป็นนิสัย, เหตุการณ์ที่เกิดขึ้นทั่วไปในปัจจุบัน, ข้อเท็จจริงหรือความจริงทั่วไป มักใช้ร่วมกับคำบอกเวลา เช่น **every day, every year, usually, often**

Examples :

I **make** a krathong **every year**.

We **celebrate** Loy Krathong **every year**.

I **usually** **go** to the river with my family.

I **often** use banana leaves to **make** a krathong.



Past Simple:

ใช้เมื่อกล่าวถึงเหตุการณ์หรือการกระทำที่ **เกิดขึ้นและสิ้นสุดแล้วในอดีต** มักปรากฏร่วมกับ **คำบอกเวลาในอดีต** เช่น last year, yesterday, last Loy Krathong

Examples :

Last year, I made a krathong with my family.

I lit the candles and floated the krathong on the river last Loy Krathong.

Last Loy Krathong, my krathong sank immediately.



Common Verb2 (Past Forms) – Useful for Festivals

Base Verb (V1)	Past Simple (V2)	Example Sentence
go	went	I went to the Songkran Festival last April.
watch	watched	I watched fireworks last December.
make	made	I made a krathong last year.
wear	wore	I wore a scary costume last Halloween.
take	took	I took photos at the festival.
light	lit	He lit the candle.



Common Verb2 (Past Forms) – Useful for Festivals

Base Verb (V1)	Past Simple (V2)	Example Sentence
join	joined	She joined the parade.
release	released	They released lanterns.
enjoy	enjoyed	We enjoyed the festival.
laugh	laughed	Everyone laughed happily.
celebrate	celebrated	We celebrated New Year with family.
dance	danced	We danced together during the festival.



Popular Festivals in Thailand

1. Lantern Festival

The Lantern Festival is celebrated in many Asian countries. People light lanterns and release them into the sky at night. It usually marks the end of the Lunar New Year celebrations. Families make wishes while letting the lanterns float away. The sky becomes bright with many floating lights.

Popular Festivals in Thailand

2. Loy Krathong Festival

Loy Krathong is a Thai festival celebrated in November. People make small floating baskets called “**krathongs**” with flowers and candles. They float the krathongs on rivers or ponds to pay respect to the water goddess. People also enjoy fireworks and cultural performances. It is a beautiful festival full of lights and traditions.

3. Songkran Festival

It is famous for water fights and fun street celebrations.

4. Phi Ta Khon Festival

Phi Ta Khon is a colorful Thai festival in Loei province. People wear ghost masks and bright costumes. They dance, parade, and play music in the streets. The festival combines Buddhist traditions and local folklore. It is lively, fun, and full of creativity.



Popular Festivals in Thailand

5. Boon Bang Fai Festival (Rocket Festival)

Boon Bang Fai Festival (Rocket Festival) is a festival in Northeastern Thailand (Isaan). People launch large handmade rockets into the sky to ask for rain. The festival includes parades, music, and traditional performances. Villagers celebrate together with food and fun activities. It is a joyful and energetic festival with lots of excitement.

Popular Festivals in Thailand

6. New Year Festival

The New Year Festival is celebrated on January 1st around the world. People count down to midnight and watch fireworks. Families and friends gather to celebrate together. People make resolutions or wish for the new year. It is a joyful festival full of hope and celebrations.

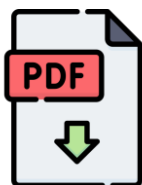

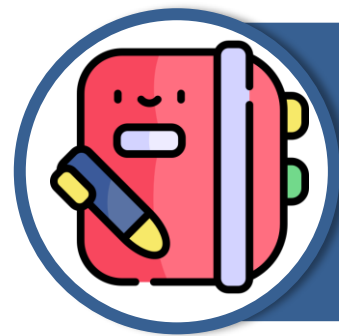

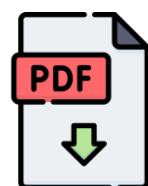
