I **have** got = I've got

You **have** got = You've got

They **have** got = They've got

We **have** got = We've got

She **has** got = She's got

He **has** got = He's got

Negative

I **have not** got = I **haven't** got

You **have not** got = You **haven't** got

They **have not** got = They **haven't** got

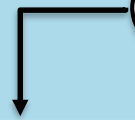
We **have not** got = We **haven't** got

She **has not** got = She **hasn't** got

He **has not** got = He **hasn't** got

I. Describing Someone's Appearance

**Appearance is defined as
the way someone or something looks.**

This is list of adjectives to describe a person's appearance:

beautiful (My younger sister is very beautiful.)

handsome (He's the most handsome man I've ever met.)

thin (She was looking pale and thin.)

tall (She's tall and thin.)

How to Describe People in English.

2. Describing Someone's Character and Personality

Character traits are qualities or characteristics that describe what a person is like.

Here is a list of English Adjectives
to describe someone's personality.

polite (Please be polite to our guests.)

friendly (Everyone was very friendly towards me.)

honest (He was a hard-working honest man.)

angry (I was very angry with myself
for making such a stupid mistake.)

3. Describing Someone's Feelings & Emotions

scared (People are scared to use
the buses late at night.)

exhausted (You look absolutely exhausted.)

nervous (She was so nervous about
her exams that she couldn't sleep.)



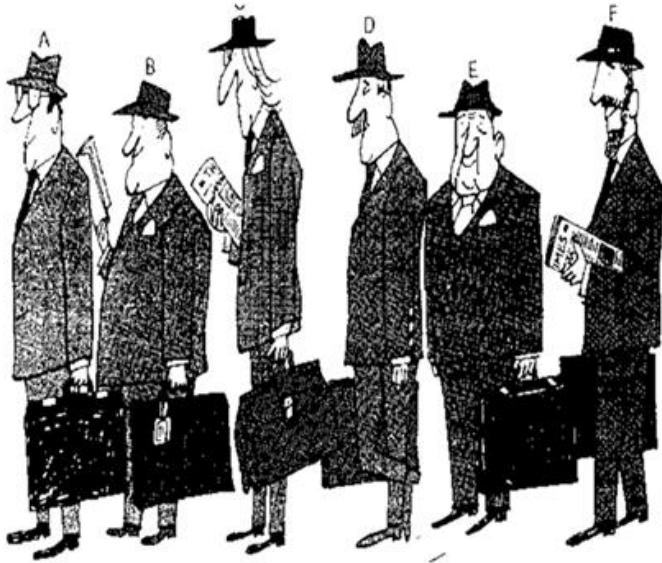

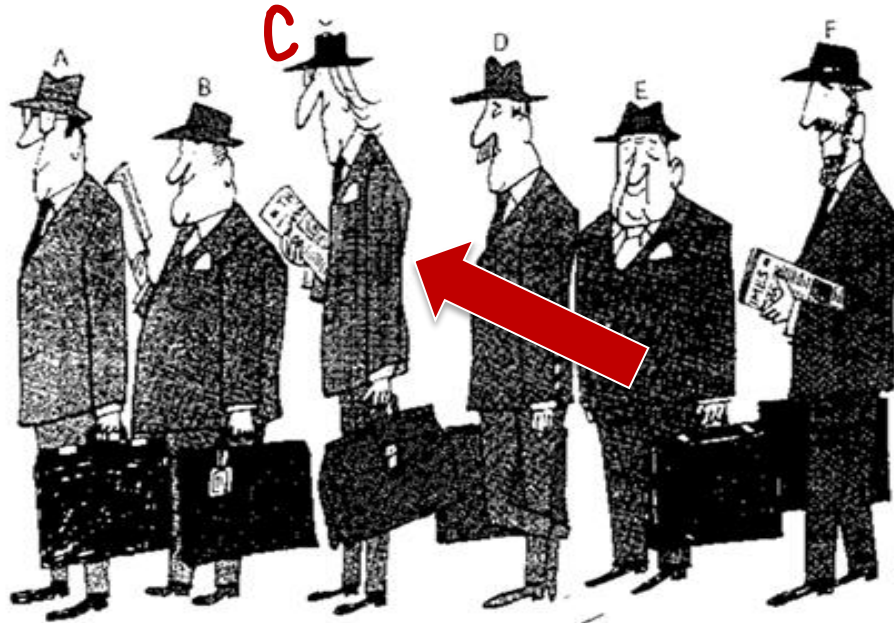
