

He was sent to prison until he could be executed. While he was in prison, he sent out letters to his friends and asked to be prayed for by writing <i>Remember your Valentine</i> .
5	Valentine was killed on the 14th or the 24th of February in the year 269 or 270. We celebrate Valentine's Day on February 14th in honor of St. Valentine.
6	Although it is not known whether this legend is factually true, it is a good story anyway. It is nice to think of someone who believed in marriage and was willing to risk death to do what he believed was right. <i>*martyr comes from the Greek word martus, which means "witness". A martyr is a person who would rather suffer, and even die, than give up the things he or she believes in.</i>


